November—Month of Remembrance of the Dead

Starting on Saturday, Nov 1st, you may bring photos of your departed loved ones to display on the Table of Remembrance in the front of the church. **Please** be sure to put your name on the back so we know to whom the picture belongs. A perpetual Book of Remembrance will also be available at each church to add the names of recently departed loved ones. You may also submit names to the office or add to the collection basket. The Table and Book will be in both churches through Thanksgiving Day.

OCIA Retreat and Rite of Entrance

Please pray for the 12 adults and 10 children in the OCIA/RCIA program who will be on retreat on **Saturday, November 8th**, at Our Lady of Good Counsel. They are inquiring about deepening their relationship with Jesus and discerning about receiving the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). They are also asking for discernment with our faith communities—and will participate in the formal Rite of Entrance and Welcoming on **Sunday, November 9th, at the 10:30am Mass** at Holy Disciples. During this Rite, the Holy Disciples and Our Lady of Good Counsel parishioners present will be invited to affirm the faith journey that these OCIA aspirants have been on—and welcome them formally as **Catechumens** (those to eventually receive all three Sacraments of Initiation) and **Candidates** (those already baptized to be received into the Catholic Church or to complete their full initiation as Catholics). Thus, they will enter a new phase in their journey toward receiving the Sacraments during the Easter Vigil in April 2026.

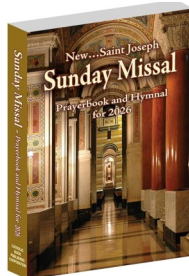

With the current federal government furloughs and the cut-back of SNAP ("Food Stamp") benefits, the number of people coming to our food banks has drastically increased. It would be most appreciated if parishioners would consider dropping off additional donations of food and other personal hygiene items. **Tuesdays and Thursdays** are the best days to bring food to the food banks, but of course, they will accept food any time. All food donations are welcome. Some examples are cereal, peanut butter, pasta, toilet paper, baby food, snacks, and other unexpired food items.

The Annual Fair Trade Sale will take place **Thanksgiving Weekend, Nov 29-30** after each weekend Mass.



Catholic Relief Services (CRS) Fair Trade will have items from artisans in developing countries. The sale of these baked goods, jewelry, chocolate, and coffee enables the artisans to be self-sustainable—proceeds support CRS. Donations to CRS are welcome as well. CRS booth sales is cash or checks only.



L'Arche Tahoma Hope will have local honey, fresh wreaths, and homemade paper gift items. Sales helps our local L'Arche create programs to celebrate diversity and the inherent value of all humans. People with intellectual disabilities find communities that value their voices.
