COMMIT TO COMMUNITY

Boulder Valley commits to community. We are a relational church and transformation happens best in circles, when rubbing shoulders in authentic relationships. The good stuff is when we show up for big and small events in life, laugh with one another, mourn with one other, and pursue God together. We want to be people about the good stuff. It is easy to spectate at church, but within Boulder Valley, faith is a team sport, and no one is on the bench. So, get involved, not just with the community here, but also in the community where God has uniquely placed you. We long for everyone to describe Boulder Valley as the place where they meet their friends and where they take their kids. But we long even more that they would use the methods of Boulder Valley as tools to create community in their own circles of influence.

CHOOSE TO CONTRIBUTE

Boulder Valley chooses to contribute. We define the process of discipleship as “Becoming more like Jesus.” This is a journey that never ends but continues to grow as we learn the Father’s heart. And because we are made in the image and likeness of our Creator, we are meant to create. Our society teaches that we are defined by what we consume. But within Boulder Valley, we make contribution, not consumption, our priority. We hope to inspire you to make this a staple of your character because we are a family on mission. We want everyone within Boulder Valley to choose to contribute in one of two places: inside or outside the structures of the church. Choosing to contribute to the mission of God is a primary way we become more like Jesus.

CONNECT TO GOD

We saved the best for last. Boulder Valley connects to God. Without this, we are merely a social club. We desire for God’s Kingdom to come, and for His will to be done. As we spend intentional time with our Creator, we hope His character begins to rub off on us. ENJOY

As leaders of Boulder Valley, we look for opportunities to celebrate, laugh, and play. We delight in the process and rest in the hope that God is the leader of the church. God calls us into a grand adventure, and we enthusiastically invite others to join us.

HEALTHY

We strive to be whole-hearted followers of Jesus. We recognize that we want to play the long game, so although we work hard, we prioritize healthy rest to sustain us. We realize conflict is inevitable, so we pursue peacemaking through seeking clarity and embracing feedback.

REAL

Our mission is to *build authentic relationships with God and one another*. As leaders, we take that very seriously. We desire to be known as people of His presence. So, we model faith and a spiritual cadence to those entrusted to our care. We lead with vulnerability and foster a culture to keep each other accountable.

ALL-IN

Our actions shape our culture, so we bring our best to everything we do. Putting aside personal preferences, we sacrifice for the sake of the mission. We trust our leaders and understand that unanimous approval isn't necessary for decision-making. We are unafraid to take risks because we serve a big God and crave a big faith.

How do we succeed?

Our Biblical mandate is to make followers of Jesus, also known as disciples. The disciples within Boulder Valley specialize in relationships. It is this lens by which we filter all our programs. With that being said, we have identified four key steps to our training process. This is how we will succeed in building authentic relationships with God and one another. Some of our programs may overlap with multiple steps, but we firmly believe every follower of Jesus needs to learn (and relearn) these steps. The journey is never over. And we won't stop *until everyone belongs*.

GRASP

- Every follower of Jesus will grasp the otherworldly love our Heavenly Father has for us (*Ephesians 3:16-19*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Launch and Alpha to help others *grasp*

GATHER

- Every follower of Jesus will gather with community on a regular basis (*Acts 2:42-47*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Sunday Mornings and Men's/Women's Ministries to help others *gather*

GROW

- Every follower of Jesus will grow in their emotional and spiritual health (*Luke 10:27*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Groups and various Trips/Retreats to help others *grow*

GO

- Every follower of Jesus will go into their circle of influence with a message (*Matthew 28:19-20*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Leadership Opportunities and Outreach Partners to help others *go*
