Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish.

Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

**¿Por qué es tan importante que nos registremos en una parroquia?
¿No es suficiente que vayamos a misa?**

La registracion es la forma oficial en la que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que porque asisten a una parroquia en particular, automáticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se casan y/o se han mudado durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos bajo la dirección de sus padres. Pero la membresía requiere registrarse, inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia.

La registracion es un compromiso con una comunidad, una forma de ser incluido en las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de su parroquia. El registro demuestra que perteneces. También es necesario para ciertos beneficios, como registrar a su hijo para las clases de educación religiosa, programar sacramentos, obtener certificados de padrinos y obtener declaraciones de donaciones para impuestos. Lo más importante es que permite que la parroquia cuente con usted para que ayude en su misión. Registrarse en su parroquia es una declaración de fe y confianza en la vida y el trabajo de su parroquia.

Lent All Year Round *Cuaresma Todo El Año*

Lent Question:

Lent always seems to help me renew my relationship with God and strengthen my religious practice. Do you have any suggestions as to what I could do to achieve that the rest of the year?

Answer:

The obvious answer may seem to be to do whatever you do during Lent all year round. But part of the power of Lent is that we focus as a community on renewing our faith and preparing for Easter. Our Lenten practices have a purpose and a goal. Therein lies the secret. When we focus our efforts on one virtue, or try to change one bad habit, or seek to deepen our understanding of one aspect of faith, we focus our efforts and give our full attention to what we are trying to accomplish. We tend to be more successful achieving our goals. More importantly, it has a ripple effect in our lives: one thing changes or is added to the spiritual mix of our lives and many aspects are changed.

All too often we leave our spiritual growth to chance and the practice of faith to habit, and then wonder why we have no sense of growth or progress. Think of it in terms of exercise. We walk, lift weights, bend and stretch to attain the maximum benefit from what we do. In addition, to keep those benefits, we eat healthful food and get enough vitamins and rest. Spirituality requires the same kind of attention: we pray, fast, read the Bible, receive sacraments, and do charitable work to maximize the benefits of practicing faith. Keeping Lent year round keeps us in spiritual shape!

Pregunta Sobre La Cuaresma:

La Cuaresma siempre parece ayudarme a renovar mi relación con Dios y fortalecer mi práctica religiosa. ¿Tienes alguna sugerencia sobre lo que podría hacer para lograrlo el resto del año?

Respuesta:

La respuesta obvia puede parecer como hacer lo que sea que hagas durante la Cuaresma durante todo el año. Pero parte del poder de la Cuaresma es que nos enfocamos como comunidad en renovar nuestra fe y prepararnos para la Pascua. Nuestras prácticas de Cuaresma tienen un propósito y una meta. Ahí está el secreto. Cuando enfocamos nuestros esfuerzos en una virtud, o tratamos de cambiar un mal hábito, o buscamos profundizar nuestra comprensión de un aspecto de la fe, enfocamos nuestros esfuerzos y prestamos toda nuestra atención a lo que estamos tratando de lograr. Tendemos a tener más éxito en el logro de nuestros objetivos. Más importante aún, tiene un efecto dominó en nuestras vidas: una cosa cambia o se agrega a la mezcla espiritual de nuestras vidas y muchos aspectos cambian.

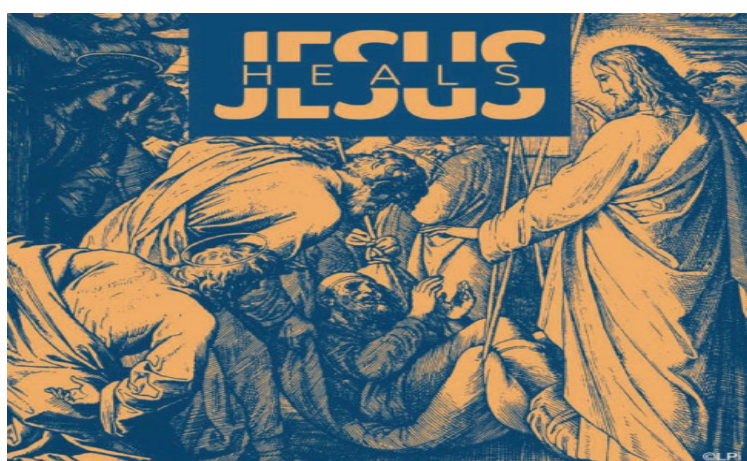
Con demasiada frecuencia dejamos nuestro crecimiento espiritual al azar y la práctica de la fe al hábito, y luego nos preguntamos por qué no tenemos un sentido de crecimiento o progreso. Piénsalo en términos de ejercicio. Caminamos, levantamos pesas, nos agachamos y nos estiramos para obtener el máximo beneficio de lo que hacemos. Además, para mantener esos beneficios, comemos alimentos saludables y obtenemos suficientes vitaminas y descanso. La espiritualidad requiere el mismo tipo de atención: oramos, ayunamos, leemos la Biblia, recibimos sacramentos y hacemos obras de caridad para maximizar los beneficios de practicar la fe. ¡Guardar la Cuaresma durante todo el año mantiene nuestra espiritualidad en forma!

Todos, quizá en algún momento de nuestra vida, hemos tenido la experiencia de jugar el papel de hijos-hijas buenos en la vida familiar. Pero, también hemos jugado el rol de no ser tan buenos como se esperaba. Entonces, esta parábola del hijo pródigo nos cae como anillo al dedo. ¿Qué sentimientos o recuerdos afluyen a tu mente al escucharla? ¿Sientes que el Padre es injusto con su hijo mayor? ¿Crees que ha consentido demasiado al menor de sus hijos? Cualquiera que sea nuestra respuesta, nos debe llevar a una reflexión profunda del amor incondicional de Dios para con sus dos hijos. Sin embargo, no perdamos el punto de vista de que Jesús cuenta esta parábola a publicanos y pecadores, y de cómo los fariseos y escribas criticaban a Jesús porque comía con ellos.

“Con la parábola del hijo pródigo Jesús nos cuenta que Dios nos espera siempre, igual que el padre, que espera el regreso de su hijo. Él nos deja libres, deja que nos equivoquemos y aprendamos, y de esta manera volver, al igual que lo hizo el hijo pródigo” (Papa Francisco). El Papa Francisco nos da la clave que debemos de llevar a cabo, aprender a volver cada vez que nos alejamos. No claudicar, seguir adelante y pedir perdón es de valientes. Aprender de los errores vividos y regresar para volver a un nuevo comienzo, pero bien acompañados de la gracia de Dios. Sentir fortaleza al escuchar: “Tú estás siempre conmigo y todo lo mío es tuyo” (Lucas 15:31).



March 30, 2025

A man looking a bit downtrodden approached me as I filled my car's gas tank. He asked, “May I share with you my testimony about how good God is?” “OK,” I skeptically answered. He went on to tell me that he had been an alcoholic and drug addict, and that God had healed him; now he was four years sober. He said, “I didn’t deserve it, but now I’m a different person. God is so good! Have a terrific Tuesday!” A few minutes later, as I drove away, I saw him smiling and handing a homeless person some money. I was confronted with a choice: either he was a total fraud or God had changed him. Something had happened to him, and it didn’t seem fake. Maybe it was God.

When Jesus heals the man born blind, the man becomes a challenge to everyone who meets him. They must decide. Is he the same blind person who they knew before? Who healed him and how? And what is the status of the one who can heal such infirmities? We shouldn’t be surprised at the storm of doubt, hatred and animosity that swirls around the healed man — so it often goes when Jesus heals someone even to this day.

Like we often do, the religious leaders confronting the healed man declare that God is not at work. They ask with mocking superiority and dismissive disdain, “You were born totally in sin, and are you trying to teach us?” (John 9:34). And they cast him out. When Jesus clearly works in our lives, in us or around us, we should accept it, and give praise and thanks for this wonderful manifestation of his goodness.

Lenten challenge: Think of one way the Lord has healed you. Perhaps he healed a form of selfishness, a physical ailment, or something else. This week, find a person to whom you can share that testimony, and share it. Don’t worry if they don’t accept it was God who did it.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. **Remember**, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday **for at least 6 months** before a certificate or letter is provided.

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If you are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

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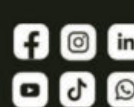
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
