Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish.

Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

**¿Por qué es tan importante que nos registremos en una parroquia?
¿No es suficiente que vayamos a misa?**

La registracion es la forma oficial en la que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que porque asisten a una parroquia en particular, automáticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se casan y/o se han mudado durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos bajo la dirección de sus padres. Pero la membresía requiere registrarse, inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia.

La registracion es un compromiso con una comunidad, una forma de ser incluido en las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de su parroquia. El registro demuestra que perteneces. También es necesario para ciertos beneficios, como registrar a su hijo para las clases de educación religiosa, programar sacramentos, obtener certificados de padrinos y obtener declaraciones de donaciones para impuestos. July 20, 2025

One of my close friends is a hermit priest who lives on a desert mountain. Recently I found myself in a group conversation about him. One vehemently objected, "What does he do up there all day? Nothing! Priests are down here working, running parishes, making a difference, and he...he is doing nothing! What a waste." The words dripped with indignation and resentment. Most of the group quietly nodded in silent agreement. Were they correct?

No! To see why, consider a similar scenario in this week's gospel. Jesus visits his friends Martha and Mary. A hardworking and exasperated Martha complains to Jesus that her sister is attending to him rather than to urgent household tasks. Our Lord, rather than praising hospitality, explicitly celebrates the less-productive sister for doing the "one necessary thing." He praises her for she "has chosen the better part" (Luke 10:42). Mary is busy doing what matters.

Before we freak out like Martha, consider that all work—domestic, manual, professional, ministerial, contemplative—is done to help us (sooner or later) to experience the love that makes us happy. We should be thankful for those who focus on the "better part" of radical, ceaseless prayer. They invite us to remember the purpose of all work is the enjoyment of love. Contemplatives, hermits, anyone fervently committed to prayer—they invite us to cast aside our forgetful, resentful, and self-aggrandizing attitudes in exchange for hearts ready to do what is finally necessary.

En este domingo, la liturgia de la Palabra nos invita a escuchar cuidadosamente la forma de recibir a los huéspedes. En la primera lectura, Abraham recibe al Señor con gran entusiasmo y le prepara un gran banquete. Dios se detiene, conversa con él y le hace la promesa de que, a su vuelta, Sara, su mujer, tendrá un hijo. "Dentro de un año volveré por aquí, y entonces Sara, tu mujer, tendrá un hijo" (Génesis 18:10). "El Señor siempre nos sorprende: cuando empezamos a escucharlo realmente, las nubes se desvanecen, las dudas dan paso a la verdad, los miedos a la serenidad y las diferentes situaciones de la vida encuentran su lugar que les corresponde. El Señor siempre, cuando viene, arregla las cosas, incluso para nosotros" (Papa Francisco).

San Agustín lo expresa de la siguiente manera en su Sermón 255: "Esta dulcísima tarea había escogido para sí María, que se mantenía inactiva; a la vez aprendía y alababa. En cambio, Marta estaba ocupada en muchas cosas. Lo que hacía era ciertamente necesario, pero pasajero: cosas para el camino, aún no las propias de la vida futura; se ocupaba del viaje, aún no de lo que iba a poseer. Había recibido, en efecto, al Señor y a cuantos iban con él". Y continúa, diciendo, explicando el texto de este domingo: "Se dignó ser recibido como huésped no por necesidad, sino por benevolencia. ¿Qué dará Dios a los que lo sirven, lo adoran, creen en él, en él ponen su esperanza y a él aman?"

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments. Opportunities to serve available for the 2025-2026 Religious Education school year commencing in September. Registration begins in June/ July. We are in need of Teachers, Teacher's Assistants, Car-line Monitors and Security Personnel. The amount of those who will serve determines the amount of children we can bring to the program!

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysomar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving.

Youth Music Ministry serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm.

Parish Evangelization Cell Groups:

One of the most powerful ways to evangelize and deepen ones relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ is by joining a small group that regularly engages in fellowship, prayer, scripture reflection and evangelism. This principle is the foundation for Cell Groups, meeting in small groups at a persons home to grow in their faith and fellowship. The ministry was brought into the Catholic Church in the USA by the late Rev. Msgr. Michel J. Eivers in 1983. Parish Cells were formally approved by the Vatican in 2015.

Altar Flowers & Garden:

A group of dedicated individuals giving of their time and talent in assisting with the preparation of weekly floral arrangements for the Altar, Church and the outside maintenance of the Church gardens.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. **Remember**, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday **for at least 6 months** before a certificate or letter is provided. Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If you are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.

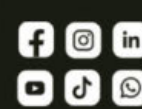

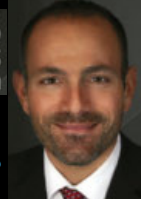

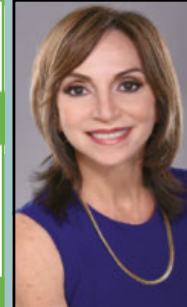
