





Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish.

Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.





September 7, 2025

One hot Arizona summer afternoon my car ran out of gas. I phoned the parish office and begged for help. My secretary came and helped me fill the gas tank. She chided me, "If you can't manage getting your car from A to B, how can we expect you to guide the parish where it needs to go?" Point taken, Julie. I vowed to always make sure I have plenty of gas in my car.

The Lord Jesus chides us in this week's Gospel, too. He uses the two images of a man building a tower and a king marching soldiers into war to make this single point: acquire what is needed to follow him or look ridiculous. We rightly mock the builder who lacks money for his tower and the king with a short-handed army. But our mocking boomerangs back on us. How do we expect to follow Jesus to the end with insufficient detachment from our possessions and divided hearts?

The good news is, there is still time. Jesus is building a great tower to heaven-his own body. So we renounce all and give ourselves to him as his precious stones. Jesus is waging a battle against our enemy. So we forsake all and swear allegiance and march under his banner. In this way, we will finish what has begun in our discipleship. Or better put, our Lord will have the stones and soldiers required to see his great work through.

Para seguir a Jesús debemos realizar ciertos cambios en la vida, que implican salir de nuestro confort. Renunciar a cosas y situaciones a las que no estamos acostumbrados, pensamos, es casi imposible. Pero, recuerde, nada es imposible para Dios. Solo basta con que pongamos un poco de nuestra parte. Dejar nuestros caprichos, manías y malos hábitos que se oponen al Evangelio es cosa de trabajo y proceso. ¡Eso cuesta seguir a Jesús! "El que no carga con su propia cruz para seguirme no puede ser discípulo mío" (Lucas 14:27).

El Papa Francisco, en su categuesis, nos ayuda a comprender el mensaje de Jesús para que nuestra carga sea ligera y apreciemos la cruz que llevamos en nuestra vida. "Hay tres características que trazan claramente la personalidad de Jesús y que motivan nuestra confianza en Él: nos encomendamos a Él porque ora, porque nos ha elegido y porque está cerca de nosotros. Jesús ha pedido y sigue pidiendo por nosotros: es el intercesor. Jesús ama y elige con amor, nos elige a todos. Y la cercanía de Dios a su pueblo es la cercanía de Jesús con la gente". A Jesús le importa nuestra libertad, no quiere que lo sigamos a ciegas. Cargar con la cruz quiere decir medir y calcular las fuerzas que tenemos y darnos cuenta de cuánta fidelidad a sus enseñanzas existe en nuestro corazón. Ayúdame, con tu gracia, cuando flagueo, cuando estoy solo y confundido, cuando estoy sin esperanza. ¿Quieres seguir a Jesús? Pues, adelante, Él te espera siempre.

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments.

Opportunities to serve available for the 2025-2026
Religious Education school year commencing in September. Registration begins in June/ July. We are in need of Teachers, Teacher's Assistants, Car-line Monitors and Security Personnel. The amount of those who will serve determines the amount of children we can bring to the program!

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysomar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving. **Youth Music Ministry** serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm.

Parish Evangelization Cell Groups:

One of the most powerful ways to evangelize and deepen ones relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ is by joining a small group that regularly engages in fellowship, prayer, scripture reflection and evangelism. This principle is the foundation for Cell Groups, meeting in small groups at a persons home to grow in their faith and fellowship. The ministry was brought into the Catholic Church in the USA by the late Rev. Msgr. Michel J. Eivers in 1983. Parish Cells were formally approved by the Vatican in 2015.

Altar Flowers & Garden:

A group of dedicated individuals giving of their time and talent in assisting with the preparation of weekly floral arrangements for the Altar, Church and the outside maintenance of the Church gardens.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. Remember, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday for at least 6 months before a certificate or letter is provided.

Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If your are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.
