





How Much Is Enough?

I've got some great news for some of you: Jesus Christ doesn't care what name you bear. He doesn't care where you were born, and he doesn't care what your family tree looks like. He doesn't care where you grew up or where you went to school.

I've also got some bad news for some of you: See above.

It's so easy to take our salvation for granted. The mercy of God makes it so. Look at John the Baptist, he was pouring water on everybody who wanted it. Everybody but one group: those who expected it. Those who thought it was a given because of who they were, because of what they were. Those who had no intention of doing the work of repentance.

Sometimes, because God is so faithful, we make the mistake of forgetting that He is also just.

I am baptized, we think. I made my First Communion, and I was Confirmed. That's enough.

I went to Catholic school. I know all the Ten Commandments and I can tell you anything you want to know about the Popes. That's enough.

I'm on parish council. I put money in the basket, and I volunteer. That's enough.

None of it is enough. It would never be enough. And before we look upon the Pharisees and Sadducees with too much judgment, we need to remember: the work of repentance is ongoing. It is a process that we must commit to within ourselves, continuously.

God is the missing element to this equation. He is the one who raises children to Abraham from the stones. If we rely only on our own abilities, our own merits, our own offerings, it will never be enough...



Parish Registration

Please register online at: www.stedward.net ("about us" on the drop-down menu) or scan the QR Code below.

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish.

Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

¿Por qué es tan importante que nos registremos en una parroquia? ¿No es suficiente que vayamos a misa?

La registracion es la forma oficial en la que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que porque asisten a una parroquia en particular, automáticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se casan y/o se han mudado durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos bajo la dirección de sus padres. Pero la membresía requiere registrarse, inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia.

La registracion es un compromiso con una comunidad, una forma de ser incluido en las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de su parroquia. El registro demuestra que perteneces. También es necesario para ciertos beneficios, como registrar a su hijo para las clases de educación religiosa, programar sacramentos, obtener certificados de padrinos y obtener declaraciones de donaciones para impuestos. Lo más importante es que permite que la parroquia cuente con usted para que ayude en su misión. Registrarse en su parroquia es una declaración de fe y confianza en la vida y el trabajo de su parroquia.

Every now and then readers of these reflections write letters in which they object to something. Years ago, this Gospel of Luke 18 prompted such an email. A man wrote to me: "I find it deeply offensive that you suggest we are still sinners once we are God's sons and daughters." His objection stirred in me a profound awareness of the paradox at the heart of our faith. Are we sinners or beloved children of God?

In this Gospel (Luke 18:9-14), a tax collector appears as one who has missed the mark. His sins have isolated him. His breast-beating is not an act of self-flagellation for pride's sake but a heartfelt admission of his failure and unworthiness. Remarkably, Jesus honors the candid humility of the parable's penitent. Why? Because we are always in need of mercy, always. But even more, perhaps because on the cross, Jesus will fully embrace a similar place of humiliation and rejection. He will enter into the most shameful, offensive place of the sinner so that we might "go home justified."

There is a sacred tension in admitting that we are sinners and yet have profound hope. We are beloved sons and daughters of God, growing precisely through our honest acceptance of failure. When we cry, "Have mercy on us," during Mass or when we repeat the "Jesus Prayer" in quiet moments, or in the confessional, we embrace our imperfections as fertile ground for divine grace. In doing so, we follow Christ's example — finding true exaltation in the humble acknowledgment of our human frailty.

Ante Dios no podemos fingir ni aparentar: Él nos conoce profundamente. Por más cara de buenos que pongamos, El ve más allá: ve nuestro corazón. Tampoco podemos decirle cuán buenos somos, porque nos conoce y sabe perfectamente nuestras acciones. Hoy, Jesús nos cuenta otra parábola: la de dos hombres que fueron al templo a orar. Cada uno lo hace a su manera, y al escuchar el relato, nos damos cuenta de que uno lo hace mejor que el otro. Pero lo más importante es que los dos hablan con Dios. Con este ejemplo podemos aprender a orar y a presentarnos ante Dios tal como somos. "Efectivamente, el fariseo, a pesar de las obras, perdió la justicia; el publicano, en cambio, se granjeó la justicia por la humildad de sus palabras. Aunque, a decir verdad, la del publicano no era propiamente humildad: de hecho, la humildad se da cuando uno que es grande se humilla a sí mismo. La actitud del publicano no fue humildad, sino verdad: sus palabras eran verdaderas, pues él era un pecador"- San Juan Crisóstomo (350–407), Homilía 2 sobre la Penitencia.

"Pero, aunque somos pecadores, no debemos desalentarnos, porque el Señor está con nosotros, quien nos ha dado todo y nos hará vencer también este pequeño paso de hoy, con la gracia de la fuerza, de la valentía, de la oración, de la vigilancia y de la alegría" (Papa Francisco). En conclusión: puede ser que en cada uno de nosotros vivan un fariseo y un publicano. Ambos necesitan de Dios para ser liberados y perdonados. Ante Dios, oremos con verdad y con sinceridad de corazón.

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysomar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving. **Youth Music Ministry** serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm. **Opportunities available for vocalist & musicians.**

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments.

Parish Evangelization Cell Groups:

One of the most powerful ways to evangelize and deepen ones relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ is by joining a small group that regularly engages in fellowship, prayer, scripture reflection and evangelism. This principle is the foundation for Cell Groups, meeting in small groups at a persons home to grow in their faith and fellowship. The ministry was brought into the Catholic Church in the USA by the late Rev. Msgr. Michel J. Eivers in 1983. Parish Cells were formally approved by the Vatican in 2015.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. Remember, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday for at least 6 months before a certificate or letter is provided.

Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If your are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.


