Why is it so important that we register in a parish?
Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. Parish registration requires signing up, and formally enrolling yourself in a parish. The weekly use of your Stewardship envelope and or Online Giving is the manner in which attendance is taken in any parish.

Registration is a commitment to a faith community, and a way to become intentionally responsible for the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also; necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish know that we can count on you as an active and participating member to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se casan y/o se han mudado durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos bajo la dirección de sus padres. Pero la registracion requiere inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia. El uso semanal de su sobre ofertorio oh su ofertorio en linea es la manera en la cual la parroquia registra su attendencia.

There are times I wish I had no obligations. It would be great to take my wife's hand, hop in the car, and drive into the sunset. Where we were going would not matter as much as the fact that we would have nowhere we *had* to be. There would be nothing we *had* to do. No bills. No commitments. No problems. *Freedom!*

Life doesn't work like that, however. When Jesus came along and asked some fishermen to drop their nets and follow him, they did just that. Wow! In some ways, they experienced true freedom. That is what Jesus offers all of us. Yet, true freedom looks quite different than my dream scenario.

In living in the true freedom that Jesus offers, there are things we must do and places we must go. That is because freedom only exists in following God's will, not our own. We are called to be and called to give ourselves completely to God without reservations. We always have the free will to not respond to His call, but we will find that a negative answer may complicate our lives even further. God's path for us calls on us to give freely of what we have been given. Saying no to that call means we carry the weight of those gifts. We were never meant to keep them. The path of God's will may seem long and winding, but it is the one that leads us into that sunset. It is the way to true freedom.





ST. THOMAS
APOSTLE



January 25, 2026

I was 22 years old, lying in bed one night while on a pilgrimage, when I suddenly sensed an idea in my mind: "Go to the seminary." There was no voice, no vision, but a gentle and unmistakable clarity.

I simply prayed, "Lord, if that's from you, let me find great joy in it." Three days later, my heart was bursting with joy. I dropped everything and entered the seminary. The older I get, the stranger my rather careless and hasty departure seems to me. I followed not because it made sense, or because I was especially brave. I went because the Lord called me.

Something like this happens in today's Gospel. Jesus walks by Simon, Andrew, James, and John and says, "Come after me" (Matthew 4:19). And immediately they leave their nets and follow. There's no explanation, no hesitation ... just movement. Why? As St. John says, "In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us" (1 John 4:10). They do not leave their nets because his call made perfect, calculable sense. They left them because they were called. And Jesus' call is powerful.

Take a moment this week to remember when Christ first called you. However small or quiet it was, recall it, and give thanks. The more we marvel that Christ has called us personally, the more passionately and freely we will follow him.

En Jesús se cumplen todas las promesas de Dios. Las palabras de Isaías en la primera lectura nos lo dicen: "El pueblo que habitaba en las tinieblas vio surgir una luz brillante". El gozo se multiplicó y la alegría aumentó. La razón de la alegría del pueblo es sencilla: se rompió el yugo que los oprimía. Experimentar la libertad es algo maravilloso, y se puede gozar de muchas formas: desde una enfermedad, a quedar sano; de estar encarcelado, y ser puesto en libertad; de relaciones no buenas, a romper con ellas. En fin, existen muchos ejemplos. Pero hay uno que debemos seguir muy de cerca: "La gente que vivía en la oscuridad ha visto una luz muy grande; una luz que ha brillado para los que viven en lugares de sombras de muerte" (Mateo 4:16).

¿En nuestra vida, cuáles son los lugares de sombra y de muerte? ¿Dónde debe entrar la luz que ilumine nuestra existencia? La conversión del corazón debe ser la guía que oriente el timón de nuestra vida. San Pablo nos indica una de tantas direcciones: que no haya divisiones entre nosotros, sino, por el contrario, que exista concordia entre las familias y la comunidad. Claramente nos recuerda que pertenecemos a Cristo. La clave está en saber vivir de acuerdo con el Evangelio. El Papa León XIV nos ofrece pautas seguras para llegar a Cristo: "Ayúdense los unos a los otros a construir puentes con el diálogo, con el encuentro, uniéndonos todos para ser un solo pueblo, siempre en paz". "La humanidad necesita de Él como puente para ser alcanzada por Dios, por su amor".

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysomar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving. **Youth Music Ministry** serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm. **Opportunities available for vocalist & musicians.**

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments.

Parish Evangelization Cell Groups:

One of the most powerful ways to evangelize and deepen ones relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ is by joining a small group that regularly engages in fellowship, prayer, scripture reflection and evangelism. This principle is the foundation for Cell Groups, meeting in small groups at a persons home to grow in their faith and fellowship. The ministry was brought into the Catholic Church in the USA by the late Rev. Msgr. Michel J. Eivers in 1983. Parish Cells were formally approved by the Vatican in 2015.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. **Remember, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday for at least 6 months** before a certificate or letter is provided. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If you are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**
