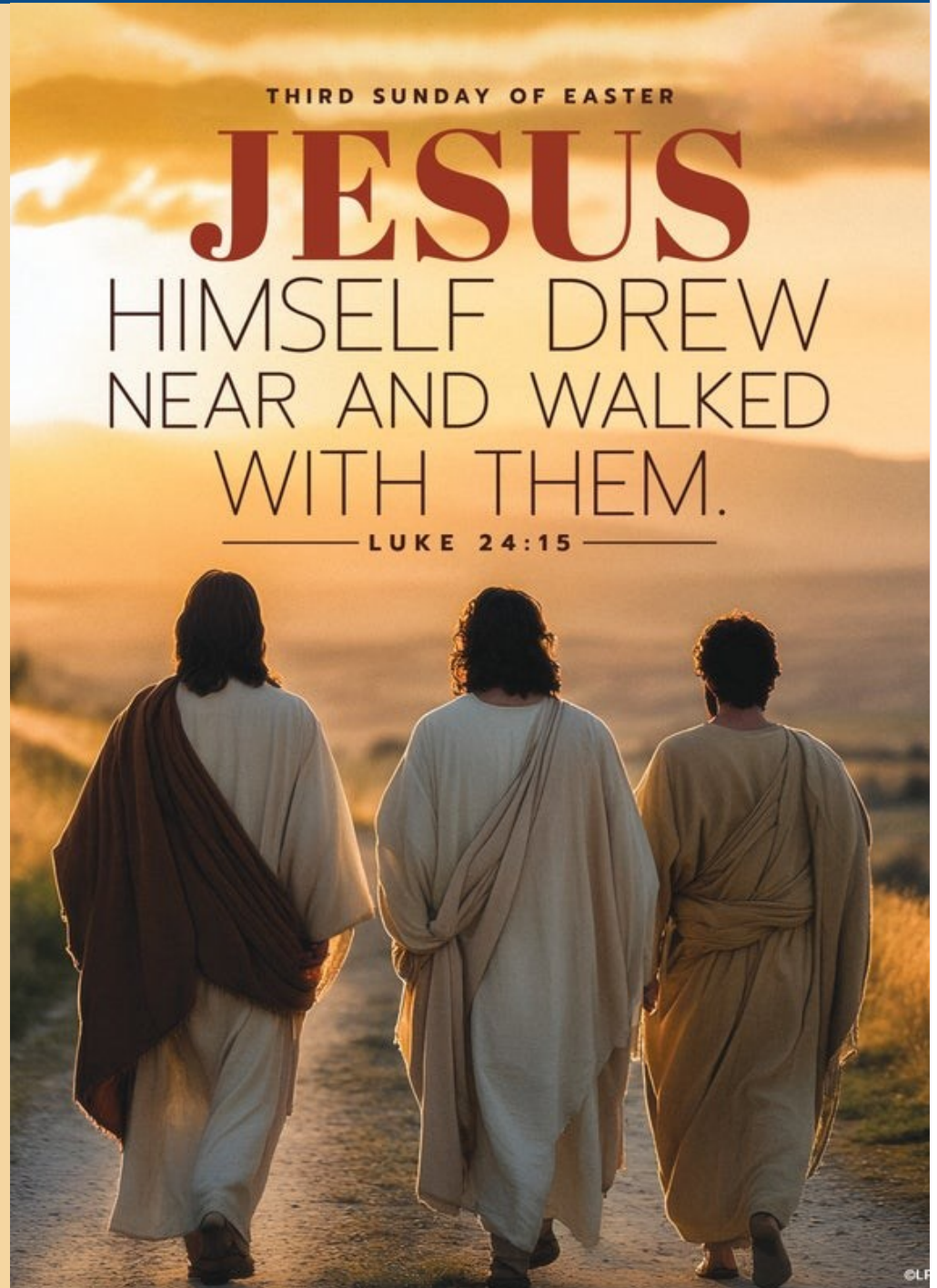

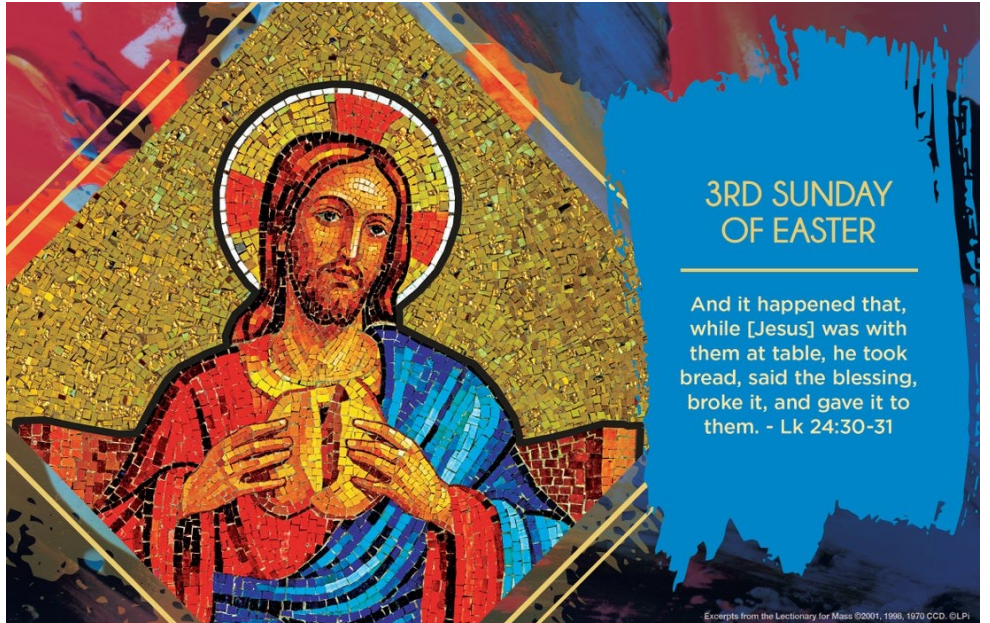

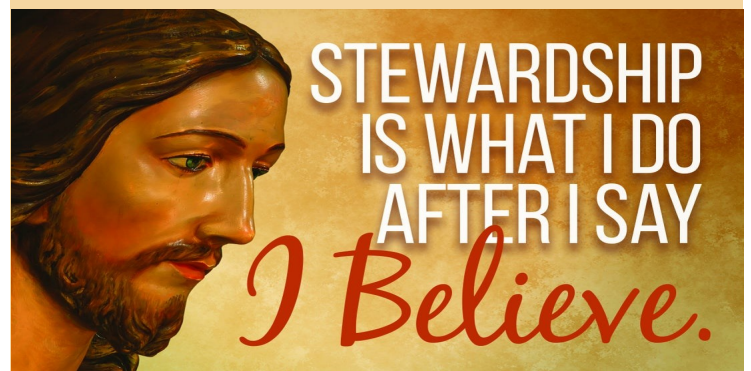

Why is it so important that we register in a parish?
Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. Parish registration requires signing up, and formally enrolling yourself in a parish. The weekly use of your Stewardship envelope and or Online Giving is the manner in which attendance is taken in any parish.

Registration is a commitment to a faith community, and a way to become intentionally responsible for the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also; necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish know that we can count on you as an active and participating member to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

Mean What You Say

Missouri is known as the "Show Me" state. Every day, Jesus calls us to respond in some way. Our response shows whether we are who we claim: his disciples. I am pretty sure Jesus is not from Missouri, but I know he is not fooled by our half-truths and misguided intentions. He also means what he says and says what he means. Shouldn't his disciples do the same?

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month:

Community Grooming is the hardest to recognize because the predator seeks to present themselves as the "ideal" person: employee, volunteer, coach, scout leader, or parent for example. In this guise, the predator builds trust and a good reputation, especially with people of authority around children, which ultimately ensures access to children. In this stage the predator advances the grooming process from seemingly innocent touching, accidental touching, increased sexualized touching, to exposing themselves and/or the child. Even if the child comes to feel something is wrong, they think they cannot say anything as this is the "ideal" person. A well-respected adult and that no one would believe them. *If you know of abuse or have a healthy suspicion of abuse, call DCF at 1-800-96ABUSE (1-800-962-2873)*

Abril es el Mes de la Prevención del Maltrato Infantil:

El "**grooming**" **comunitario** es el más difícil de detectar porque el depredador intenta presentarse como la persona "ideal": por ejemplo, un empleado, un voluntario, un entrenador, un líder de exploradores, o un padre/una madre. Bajo esta apariencia, el depredador se gana la confianza y se labra una buena reputación, especialmente entre las personas con autoridad que rodean a los niños, lo que, en última instancia, le garantiza el acceso a ellos. En esta etapa, el depredador avanza en el proceso de "grooming" o manipulación, pasando de tocar con aparente inocencia, a tocar accidentalmente, a toques cada vez más sexualizados, hasta exponerse a sí mismo y/o a los niños. Incluso si los niños llegan a sentir que algo está mal, piensan que no pueden decir nada, ya que se trata de la persona "ideal", un adulto muy respetado, y que nadie les creería.

When I first read Homer's *Odyssey* as a teenager, one scene captured my imagination: Odysseus finally returning home after 20 years, yet no one recognized him. Disguised as a beggar, he speaks with his wife, his son, and even his enemies. He is fully present, yet hidden. Only at the right moment does he reveal himself, and everyone realizes he has been with them all along. I was struck by the mystery that he could be so close to his loved ones, and yet they simply could not identify him.

A similar mystery is at the heart of today's Gospel. Two disciples walk the road to Emmaus with Jesus, but "their eyes were prevented from recognizing him." (Luke 24:16) He listens, teaches, and eats with them, yet they remain blind until he breaks the bread. Suddenly their eyes are opened — and at that very moment, he vanishes. His disappearance is not absence. Rather, it is revelation. The Risen Lord is now present in a new way, in the breaking of the bread and in the life of His Church.

Faith is this shift of vision. Instead of searching for a visible Jesus as if he were absent, we learn to recognize him unveiled in hidden ways — in Scripture proclaimed, in the Eucharist, in the sacraments, in the very life of the Church.

And what is true of him is true of us. Just as he disappears into the mission of his Body, we too are meant to be hidden in him. When we live hidden in Christ, we are seen for who we really are.

Así de importante es el camino de Emaús, que escuchamos cada tercer Domingo de Pascua. Jesús explica las Escrituras por el camino, no en una sinagoga; se le invita a quedarse en casa porque el día se acaba, y lo más hermoso: parte el pan para todos nosotros. No hay mejor manera de continuar celebrando la Pascua que invitar a Jesús Resucitado a casa, para platicar con Él, contarle lo que nos pasa, las alegrías y las tristezas, por medio de la oración. Para que Él renueve nuestra esperanza y nuestra fe. ¡Feliz Pascua!

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysomar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving.

Youth Music Ministry serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm.

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):

The preparation of adult candidates for Catholic sacraments. Must be 18 years of age or older.

Our Lady's Workshop:

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. **Remember, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday for at least 6 months** before a certificate or letter is provided. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If you are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**
