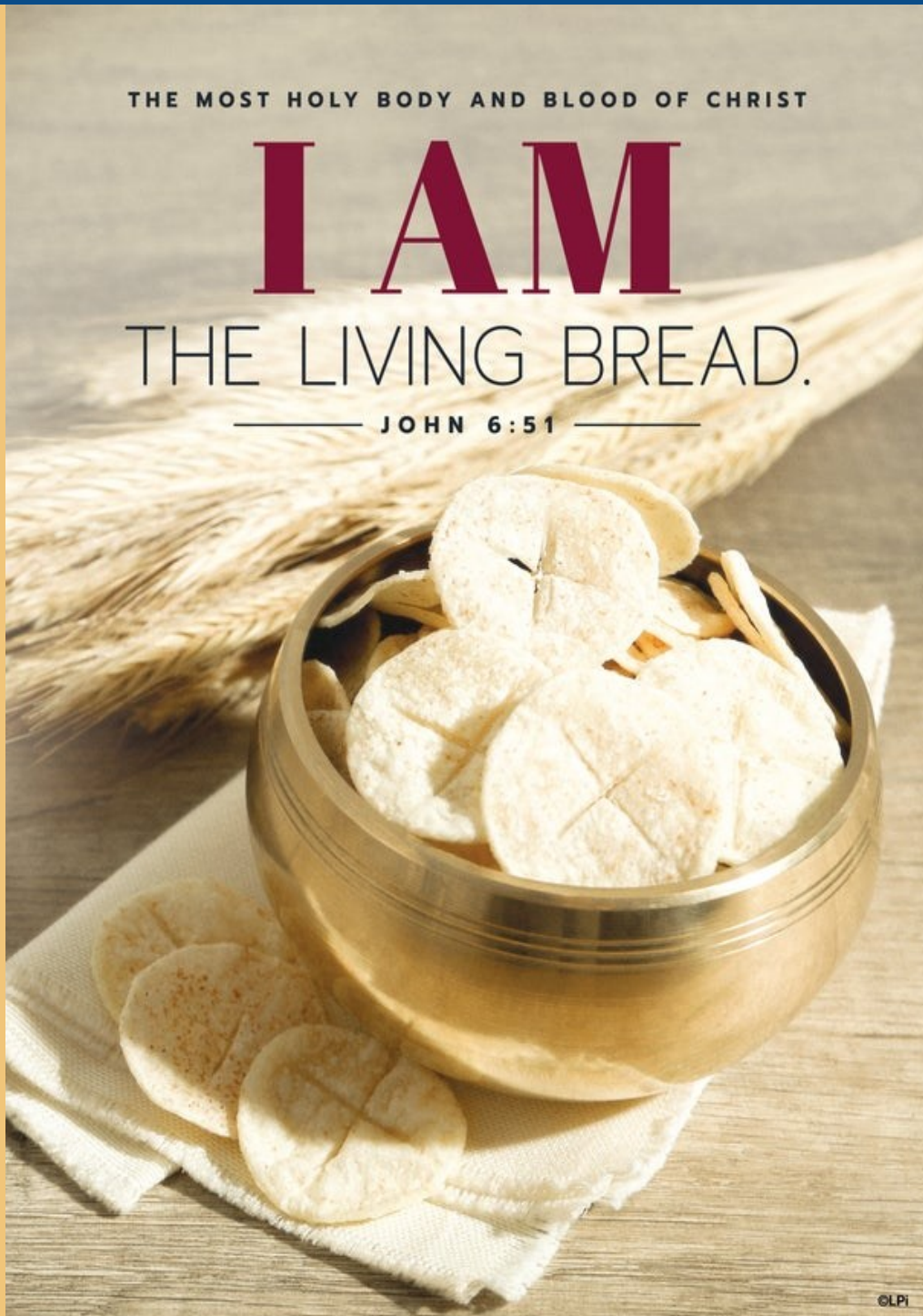

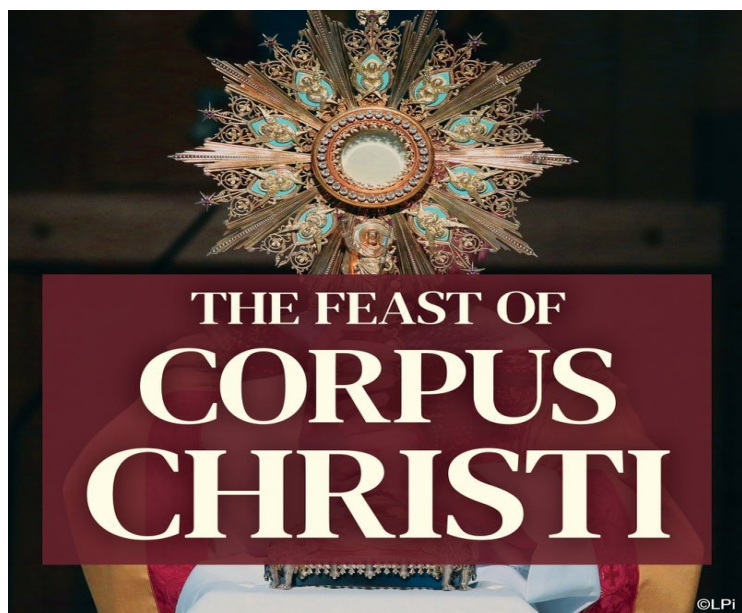

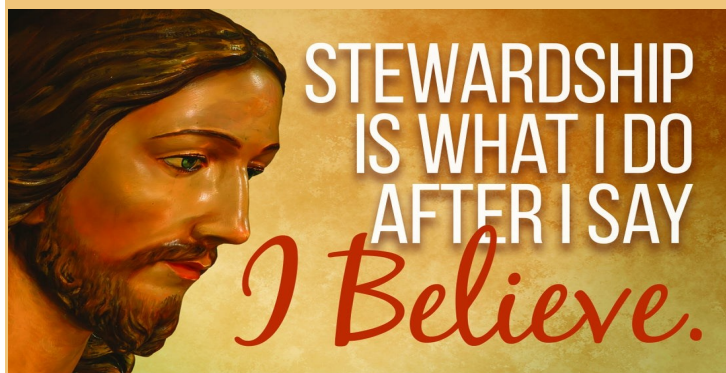

Why is it so important that we register in a parish?
Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. Parish registration requires signing up, and formally enrolling yourself in a parish. The weekly use of your Stewardship envelope and or Online Giving is the manner in which attendance is taken in any parish.

Registration is a commitment to a faith community, and a way to become intentionally responsible for the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also; necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish know that we can count on you as an active and participating member to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

**¿Por qué es tan importante que nos
registremos en una parroquia?

La registracion es la forma oficial en la que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que porque asisten a una parroquia en particular, automáticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se casan y/o se han mudado durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos bajo la dirección de sus padres. Pero la registracion requiere inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia. El uso semanal de su sobre ofertorio oh su ofertorio en linea es la manera en la cual la parroquia registra su asistencia.

La registracion es un compromiso con una comunidad de fe, una forma de ser intencionalmente responsable por las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de su parroquia. El registro demuestra que perteneces. También es necesario para ciertos beneficios, como registrar a su hijo para las clases de educación religiosa, programar sacramentos, obtener certificados de padrinos y obtener declaraciones de donaciones para impuestos. 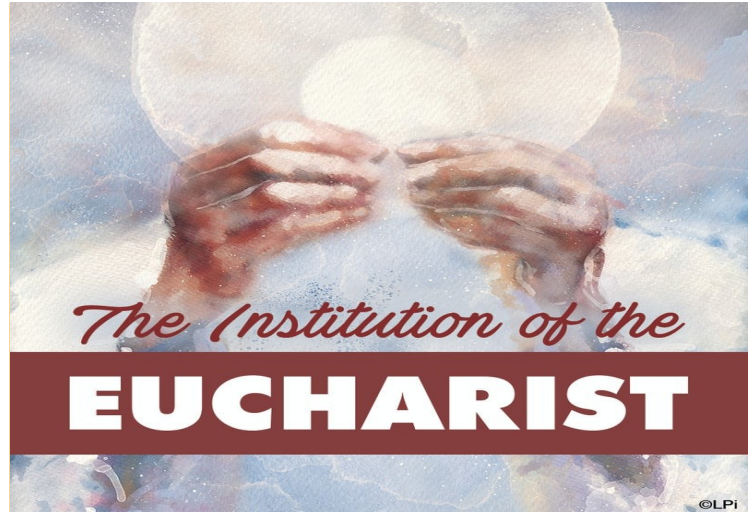

INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK**

The starving Israelites found their physical salvation in manna, "a food unknown to your fathers." We find our spiritual salvation in the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, a food unknown to too many souls.
Blessed are we to partake of the Bread of Life.



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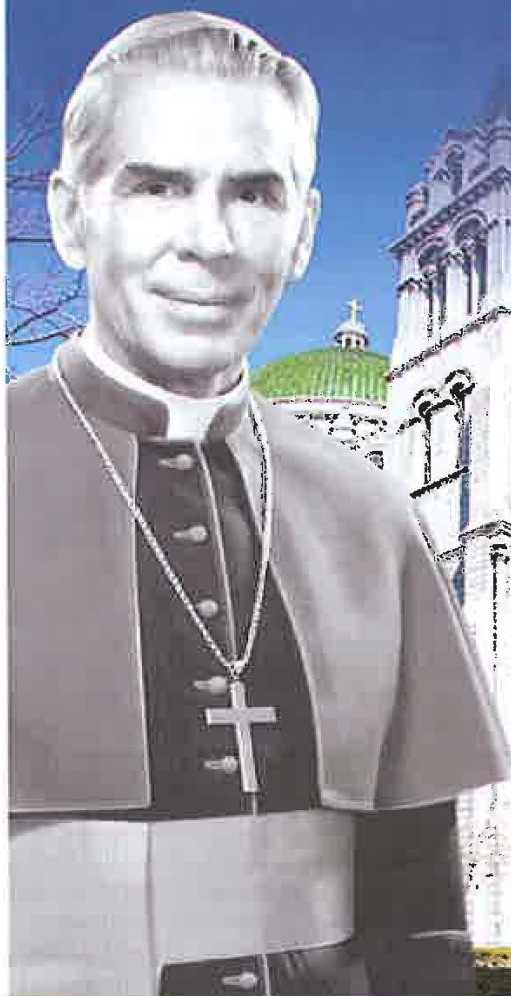

When I was a young altar server, I once overheard two very different comments about the Eucharist. One person asked, "Is Father distributing the bread or the wine?" Later, another asked, "Can you go get Jesus from the tabernacle?" Same parish, same Mass, but two very different ways of speaking. I pondered: So, is it bread that we pretend is Jesus? Or is Jesus a tiny white thing in a box? I was utterly confused.

This Feast of Corpus Christi is an excellent time to think about how we should speak about the Eucharist. In today's Gospel, Jesus declares: "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." (John 6:55) His words scandalized his listeners, who feared cannibalism, and even today puzzle many, who reduce them to metaphor. Both miss the truth.

The Church gives us better words that honor Jesus' words in the Gospel. After the consecration, we do not call it "bread" or "wine." Nor do we say, "a piece of Jesus" or even "Jesus." We say: the Eucharist. We say: the Body and Blood of Christ. We say: the Real Presence. We say: the Most Blessed Sacrament. These words safeguard the astonishing reality that Christ himself is truly present, whole and entire, under the appearances of bread and wine.

If we speak well about the Eucharist, we will think more clearly and believe more deeply. And if we believe more deeply, we will adore more truly the One who gives himself to us — not bread, not wine, but Jesus Christ himself, whole and entire.

Gracias, Jesús. Nos das tu Cuerpo y tu Sangre para alimentarnos; nos lo has dado todo, no te has quedado con nada para ti, hasta la última gota de tu sangre: "Pero al llegar a Jesús, vieron que ya estaba muerto, y no le quebraron las piernas, sino que uno de los soldados le abrió el costado con la lanza, y al instante salió sangre y agua" (Juan 19:33-34).

Nos diste al Padre, para que sea nuestro Padre; nos enviaste al Espíritu Santo, para que nos guíe en la vida; nos diste a María como Madre al pie de la cruz. Nos lo has dado todo, por eso solo me queda decir: Gracias, Señor, por todo tu amor por nosotros.

¿Cómo responder a tanto amor? ¿Qué debo hacer en particular y en comunidad? Acudamos cada domingo con un corazón agradecido, para dar gracias y alabar al Señor por la Eucaristía. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (número 1324) explica: "La Eucaristía es fuente y cima de toda la vida cristiana. Los demás sacramentos, como también todos los ministerios eclesiales y obras de apostolado, están unidos a la Eucaristía y a ella se ordenan. La sagrada Eucaristía, en efecto, contiene todo bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua." Es bueno que, durante la semana, meditemos en las palabras del Evangelio de este domingo. Jesús dijo: "Yo soy el pan vivo, bajado del cielo. Si uno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre... el que come mi Carne y bebe mi Sangre, tiene vida eterna... permanece en mí y yo en él" (Juan 6:51-56; CIC 1406).

¡Sigamos unidos a Cristo por medio de su Cuerpo y de su Sangre!

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysomar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving.

Youth Music Ministry serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm.

Opportunities available for vocalist & musicians.

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):

The preparation of adult candidates for Catholic sacraments. Must be 18 years of age or older.

Opportunities available for those wanting to serve as class aides and those seeking to continue to grow in their faith through lessons and group discussions.

Rosary Ministry:

All are welcomed to join. Monday through Friday at 7:30am inside the church to pray the rosary before morning Mass. Please scan the QR Code to follow along.

Our Lady's Workshop:

Our group gathers on the 3rd Thursday of each month in the JP II conference room to make and teach others to fashion rosaries of different kinds for our parish ministries, sacramental candidates, and our parish community. We believe that for every rosary we place in someone's hands, one more rosary will surely be prayed.



Parish Evangelization Cell Groups:

One of the most powerful ways to evangelize and deepen ones relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ is by joining a small group that regularly engages in fellowship, prayer, scripture reflection and evangelism. This principle is the foundation for Cell Groups, meeting in small groups at a persons home to grow in their faith and fellowship. The ministry was brought into the Catholic Church in the USA by the late Rev. Msgr. Michel J. Eivers in 1983. Parish Cells were formally approved by the Vatican in 2015.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. **Remember, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday for at least 6 months** before a certificate or letter is provided. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If you are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**
