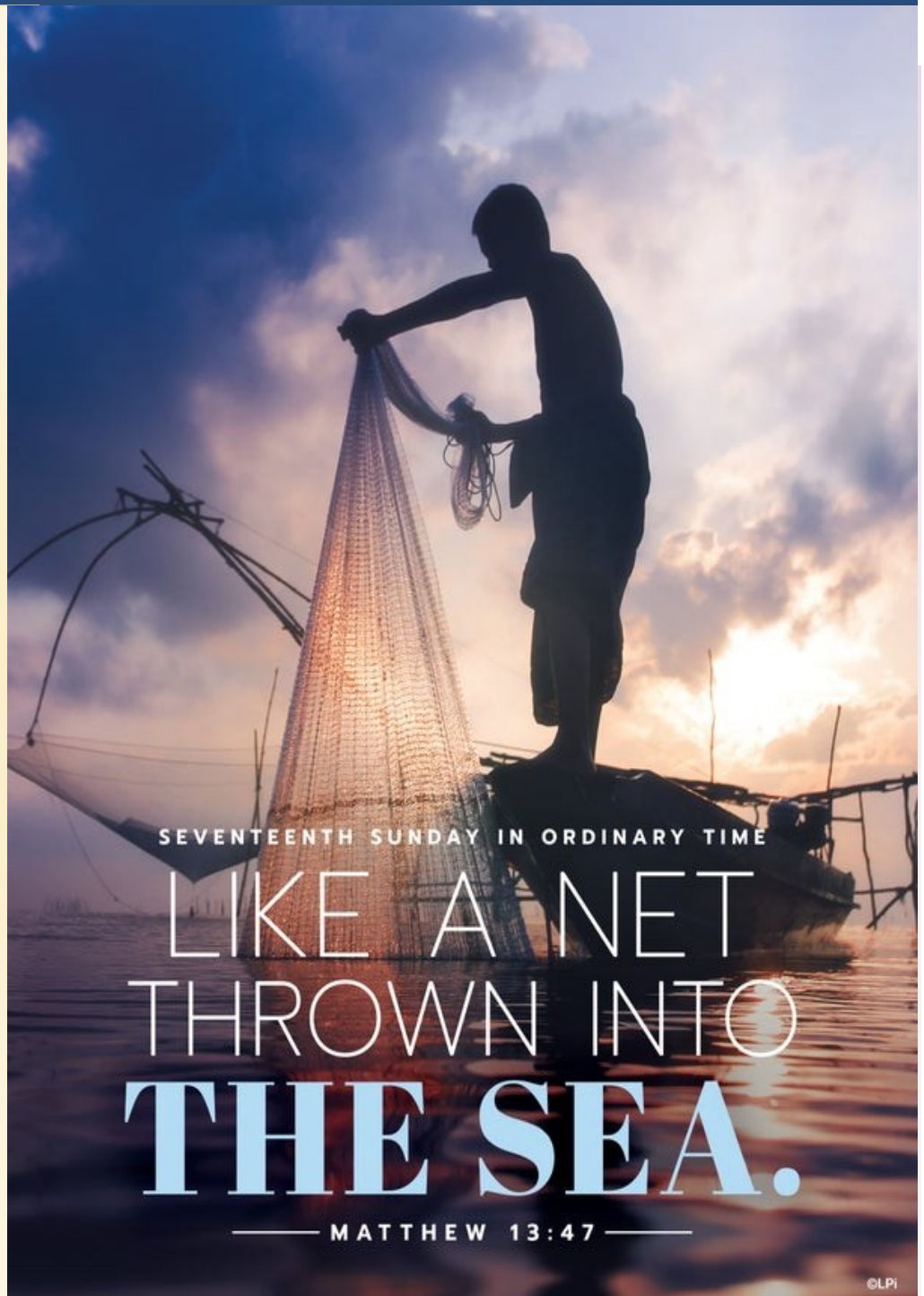

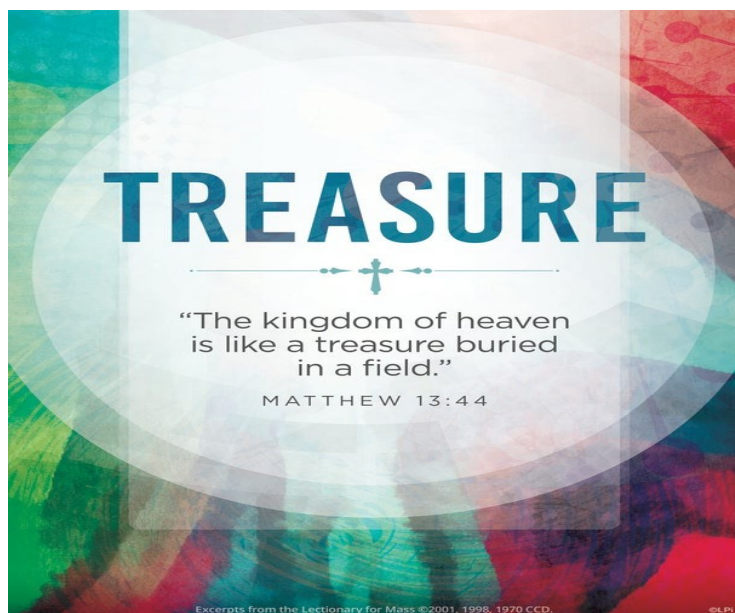

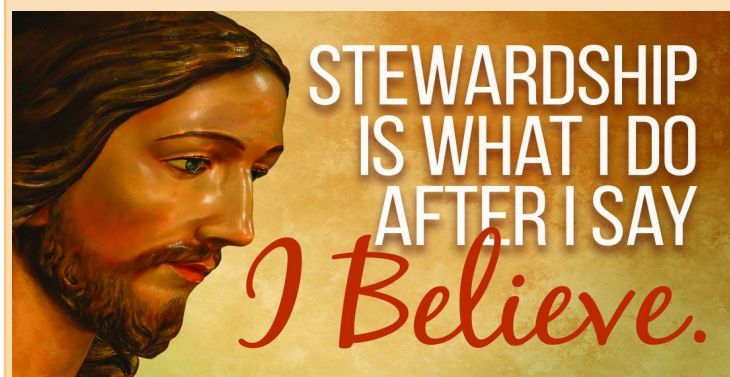

Why is it so important that we register in a parish?
Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who get married and/or have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. Parish registration requires signing up, and formally enrolling yourself in a parish. The weekly use of your Stewardship envelope and or Online Giving is the manner in which attendance is taken in any parish.

Registration is a commitment to a faith community, and a way to become intentionally responsible for the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also; necessary for certain benefits, like registering your child for religious education, scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish know that we can count on you as an active and participating member to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

¿Por que es tan importante que nos registremos en una parroquia? ¿No es suficiente que vayamos a misa?

La registracion es la forma oficial en la que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que porque asistena una parroquia en particular, automaticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jovenes que se casan y/o se han mudado durante anos piensan que todavia estan inscrites bajo la direccion de sus padres. Pero la registracion requiere inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia. El uso semanal de su sobre ofertorio o su ofertorio en linea es la manera en la cual la parroquia registra su asistencia.

La registracion es un compromiso con una comunidad de fe, una forma de ser intencionalmente responsable por las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de su parroquia. 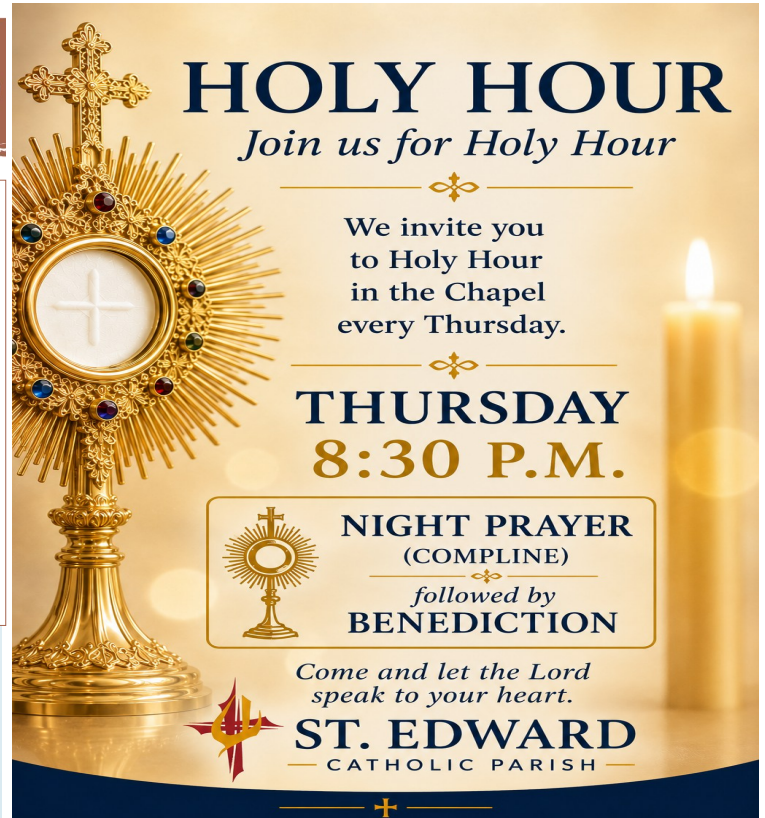

Around the time that the gold rushes ended in the nineteenth-century West, a curious phenomenon arose in New England known as money diggers. These were men who roamed the countryside with shovels, divining rods, and superstitious hope, convinced that treasure lay buried beneath their feet. Surely there must be gold under our feet. But there was not. The craze of these wild goose chases caused many to lose farms, families, and sanity.

In this week's Gospel, Jesus inaugurates a new era of spiritual money digging. He announces, "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field." He invites us to become treasure seekers who search in the right place. What is of greatest value is not money beneath our feet, but the infinite treasure hidden deep in the humanity of Jesus himself, God's own blessed life. The glory of heaven lies veiled in his ordinary life, his teaching, his suffering, his Church.

This teaching about the Kingdom changes things. Now we see the Church's doctrinal and moral teachings are not arbitrary rules. They are a treasure map. Follow them, and we will uncover divine happiness. Ignore them, and we will wander aimlessly, spade in hand, digging in empty fields, discouraged.

Where have we wasted energy seeking treasure in the wrong places? How have we given up on seeking the treasure of truly finding God's love for us? If so, let us repent of both. Then let us dust off our shovels and get back to digging deep into the field of Christ Jesus and his Church. After all, He never ceases seeking his treasure in us.

La Exhortación Apostólica Evangelii Gaudium (La alegría del Evangelio), del Santo Padre Francisco, nos habla de la alegría que llena el corazón del cristiano al escuchar la Palabra de Dios y ponerla en práctica. "La alegría del Evangelio llena el corazón y la vida entera de los que se encuentran con Jesús. Quienes se dejan salvar por Él son liberados del pecado, de la tristeza, del vacío interior y del aislamiento. Con Jesucristo siempre nace y renace la alegría" (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 1). Sin embargo, por el otro lado de la moneda, es decir, desde la lógica del mundo, se nos dice que la alegría es algo material, y es tener muchas cosas para alcanzar la felicidad. Pero todo eso es vano y pasajero; la verdadera alegría se encuentra en otro lugar y hay que poner empeño para buscarla.

El Evangelio de hoy nos habla de un tesoro escondido en un campo, de perlas finas y de una red lanzada al mar. Dejar todo lo que se tiene para obtener lo encontrado y luchar por conservarlo es un reto difícil. Esto se obtiene solo cuando se le encuentra sentido a lo encontrado y se reconoce que vale más que todo lo que ya se posee. ¡Qué felices somos cuando descubrimos algo que realmente vale la pena, que da sentido y dirección a nuestra vida! Entonces nos decimos: "Esto sí vale la pena". Jesús no se cansa de invitarnos a la búsqueda de su Reino: a encontrar el tesoro de su gracia en nuestro corazón, a valorar la perla preciosa de sus sacramentos y a lanzar la red de la paz y la alegría en nuestro entorno familiar y comunitario. ¡Señor, que tu Reino sea nuestra esperanza!

Lectors:

In the Catholic Church, a lector, also known as a reader, is a lay steward who proclaims the readings from Sacred Scripture at Mass, excluding the Gospel. They are entrusted with delivering the Word of God to the congregation, their role extends beyond simply proclaiming to convey the message with clarity, reverence, and conviction. Must be punctual and committed to preparing for their scheduled reading during the week. Should have already completed their Sacraments of Initiation.

Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers):

In the Catholic Church, ministers of hospitality or ushers are lay steward liturgical ministers who play a crucial role in creating a welcoming and comfortable environment for parishioners. They assist in various ways during the liturgy, including greeting attendees, helping them find their seats, collecting offerings, distributing bulletins, and assisting those with special needs.

Music Ministry (Adult & Youth):

Join together in song under our director of Liturgical Music Dr. Ysamar Granados. Attendance to weekly rehearsals and a commitment to timely attending your designated Mass times are critical to those serving.

Youth Music Ministry serves during the Anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturdays at 5:00pm.

Religious Education:

Serving as an educator in preparing our youth to grow in our faith and receive their sacraments.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):

The preparation of adult candidates for Catholic sacraments. Must be 18 years of age or older.

Opportunities available for those wanting to serve as class aides and those seeking to continue to grow in their faith through lessons and group discussions.

Rosary Ministry:

Our Lady's Workshop:

Our group gathers on the 3rd Thursday of each month in the JP II conference room to make and teach others to fashion rosaries of different kinds for our parish ministries, sacramental candidates, and our parish community. We believe that for every rosary we place in someone's hands, one more rosary will surely be prayed.



Parish Evangelization Cell Groups:

One of the most powerful ways to evangelize and deepen ones relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ is by joining a small group that regularly engages in fellowship, prayer, scripture reflection and evangelism. This principle is the foundation for Cell Groups, meeting in small groups at a persons home to grow in their faith and fellowship. The ministry was brought into the Catholic Church in the USA by the late Rev. Msgr. Michel J. Eivers in 1983. Parish Cells were formally approved by the Vatican in 2015.

Looking to be a Sponsor or a Godparent? Please Pay Close Attention!

To be considered an active/participating member of the parish, and eligible to receive a Sponsor/Godparent eligibility certificate or parish verification letter, St. Edward asks that you first be registered in our parish **for a minimum of 6 months**, attend **Holy Mass** consistently (Sunday to Sunday), and show a continuous commitment to your Stewardship as a way of life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent, and treasure.

Godparents and Sponsors are called to be good stewards committed to daily prayer, giving responsibility to the church, and committed to serving God and neighbor. Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.

Here at St. Edward, as well as most parishes in the United States, the weekly offertory envelope and/or online giving are the primary means of recording a parishioner's participation in the weekend Mass or Holy Days of Obligation. The offertory contribution is a way of saying "Thank you, God" for all the blessings he has given us by returning a portion of your income, as a percentage, or a tithe to the Lord in a meaningful way.

Parish registration is available Online at www.stedward.net and is required before St. Edward can issue a sponsor certificate or parish verification letter for those asked to be a sacramental Sponsor/Godparent. **Remember, you must be a registered contributing member and attending Mass Sunday to Sunday for at least 6 months** before a certificate or letter is provided. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**

Catholic School Tuition Discount

If you are planning to send your student to a local Catholic School, there is important information you need to know to receive the tuition discount. Catholic Schools will request us to verify that you are a **REGISTERED** member of the parish, attending **MASS SUNDAY TO SUNDAY** and **CONTRIBUTING FINANCIALLY** to the parish in a **MEANINGFUL WAY**.

Here at St. Edward, we strive toward the Stewardship Way of Life by returning to God a portion of your time, talent and treasure.

Please use your parish envelopes or online giving to verify your financial offering to the parish and attendance to mass as a practicing Catholic. **Mass attendance is recorded by the weekly use of your parish envelope.**

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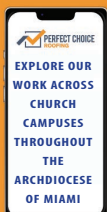

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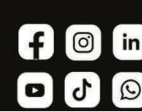
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
