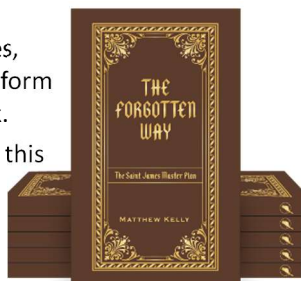


A Christmas Gift

"Lord, teach me to love as You love."

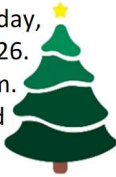


The Parish Office will be **closed** for Christmas from Tuesday, December 23rd, 2025, through Thursday, January 1st, 2026.
