

2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time - A Reflection

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." This is the beginning of the Gospel of John. The other three gospels are called the "synoptic" gospels because they are more straightforward accounts—synopses—of the life of Jesus. The Gospel of John, on the other hand, begins with this sweeping, mystical poem about God and the nature of God. After introducing us to the Word, the gospel introduces us to John the Baptist. We zoom in on the Word made flesh, and thus the story of Jesus Christ begins—not with the nativity, but right in the middle. John the Baptist, messenger and prophet, sets the stage for us. He says: "After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me." John doesn't mean that Jesus is older than him; he speaks of the deepest, ultimate precedence. John goes forth to tell the new story of the incarnation, but also to tell the oldest story that has ever been told. This story proves popular and dangerous; in the end, the king kills John for telling it...." (Source: uscatholic.org)
