Today's readings strike a powerful chord between the reality of human fear and the assurance of divine love. Jeremiah feels the "whisperings" of betrayal, and in the Gospel, Jesus acknowledges that following Him involves risk. Yet, the core message isn't about the danger; it's about your value. Jesus uses the image of sparrows-pennies in the marketplace-to remind you that if God tracks the smallest bird, He certainly has His eyes on you. We are invited today to stop looking at the "terror on every side" and start looking at the Father who has counted every hair on our heads.

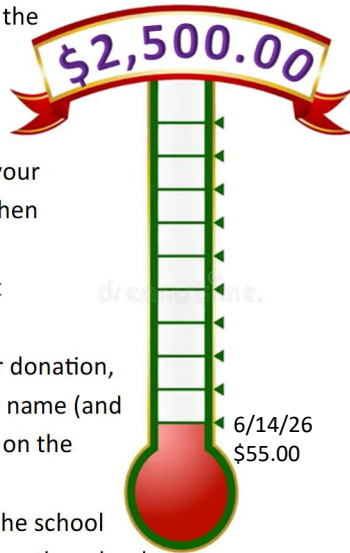

SOME CATHOLIC RITUALS CENTER ON ANCIENT, SYMBOLIC PRACTICES

Many Catholic rituals carry rich symbolism. For instance:

- The **use of incense** symbolizes prayers rising to heaven;
- **Ashes** placed on the forehead on Ash Wednesday recall penance and mortality; and
- The **Sacred Heart devotion** has its roots in 17th-century spirituality, linking Christ's heart with love and sacrifice.

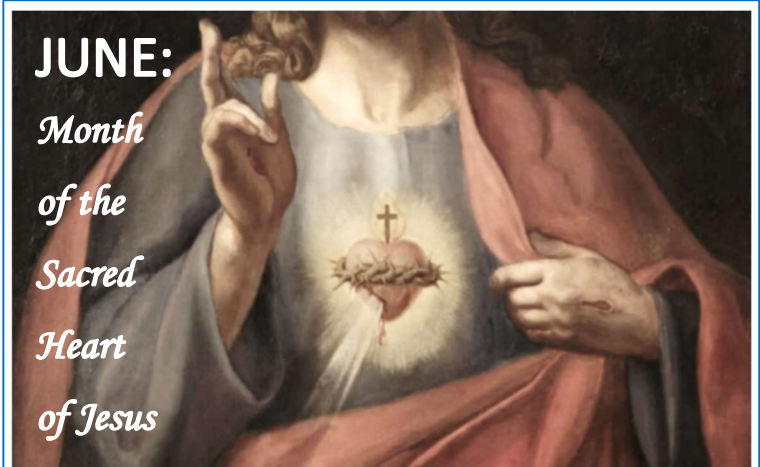
These symbolic practices date back centuries and invite reflection beyond mere ceremony.

7 Ways to Grow in Devotion to the Sacred Heart this June

Let's participate with the Church in dedicating June to the Sacred Heart in our lives and homes so that our love and devotion to Jesus will grow deeper. Here are a few things we can do to answer Our Lord's call to honor His Heart.

1. **Pray the Sacred Heart of Jesus Novena.** We can start this 9 days before the Feast of the Sacred Heart.
2. **Consecrate yourself** and your family to the Sacred Heart. This is a wonderful conclusion to the Novena and can be prayed on the Feast Day. Many families renew their consecration on each anniversary.
3. **Learn the 12 Promises** of the Sacred Heart that Jesus gave to Saint Margaret Mary. We can pray these promises when are worried or we experience other trials.
4. **Make frequent visits to Jesus** in the Blessed Sacrament. In the Eucharist, we encounter the heart of Christ and unite ourselves to this Heart by receiving Holy Communion. We love and console His Heart during adoration.
5. **Enthroned your home to the Sacred Heart of Jesus** by placing an image or icon of the Sacred Heart in a prominent place and having your priest visit to bless your home and pray the Enthronement prayers.
6. **Participate in the First Fridays Devotion** by attending Mass, going to Confession, and receiving Jesus in the Eucharist on the first Friday of 9 consecutive months. You can start in June or on the first Friday of any month.
7. Lastly, **strive to live a life that reflects the virtues** of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Seek to imitate, by God's grace, the self-giving, sacrificial love of Jesus for the Father and for humanity.
