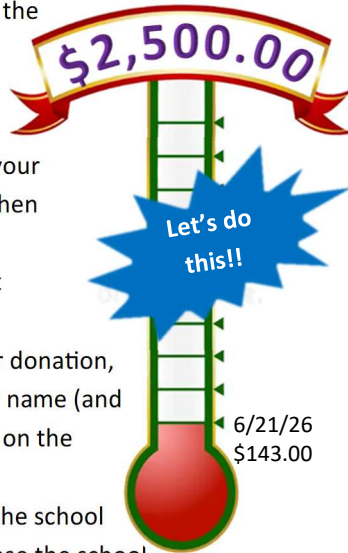

Prayer of Consecration to the Sacred Heart

by Pope Leo XIII

Most sweet Jesus, redeemer of the human race, look down upon us, humbly prostrate before your altar. We are yours and yours we wish to be; but to be more surely united with you, behold each one of us freely consecrates himself today to your most sacred heart. Many, indeed, have never known you, many too, despising your precepts, have rejected you. Have mercy on them all, most merciful Jesus, and draw them to your sacred heart. Be king, O Lord, not only of the faithful who have never forsaken you but also of the prodigal children who have abandoned you; grant that they may quickly return to their father's house, lest they die of wretchedness and hunger. Be king of those who are deceived by erroneous opinions, or whom discord keeps aloof, and call them back to the harbor of truth and unity of faith, so that soon there may be but one flock and one shepherd. Be king also of all those who sit in the ancient superstition of the Gentiles, and do not refuse to deliver them out of darkness into the light and kingdom of God. Grant, O Lord, to your Church, assurance of freedom and immunity from harm; give peace and order to all nations, and make the earth resound from pole to pole with one cry: Praise to the divine heart that wrought our salvation; to it be glory and honor forever. Amen.

WHAT DOES "CATHOLIC" MEAN?

The word "Catholic" means "universal." The term comes from the Greek *katholikos* meaning "toward the whole" or "general/universal." From early on, Christians used "the catholic church" to designate the universal church of Christ.

The first use of "Catholic Church" as a phrase dates to around AD 110. The earliest recorded use of the phrase "Catholic Church" is attributed to Ignatius of Antioch in a letter to the Smyrnaeans, around AD 110. That speaks to the long historical depth of the institution.
