Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ – *The Living Bread*

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever." (Jn. 6:51-58)

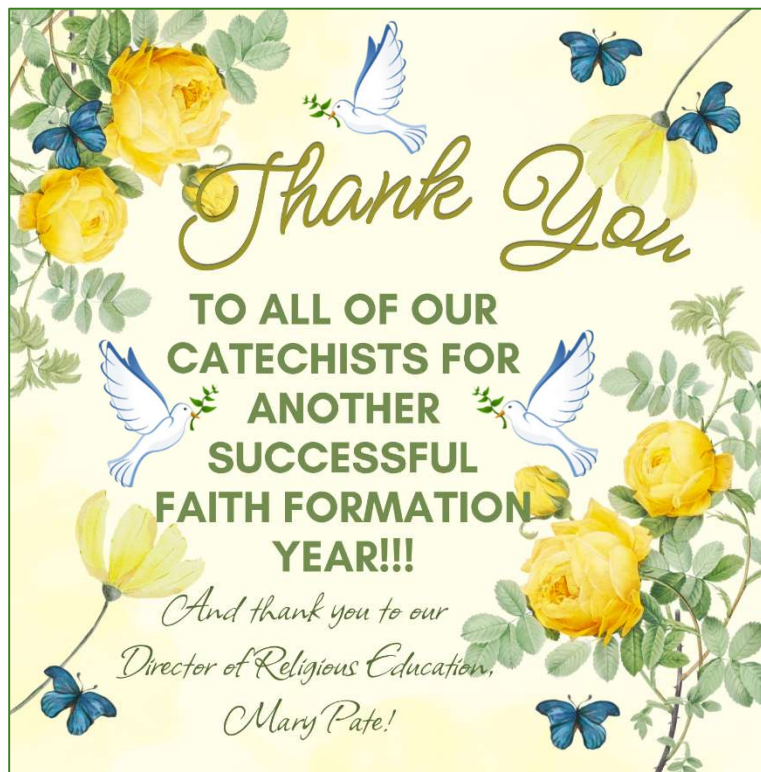

Why is June Dedicated to the Sacred Heart?

June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the Catholic tradition because of the **FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART**, which is celebrated on the Friday that follows the second Sunday after Pentecost. This feast commemorates the intensity of love and compassion of Jesus Christ as symbolized by His heart, fervently burning with love for humanity.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart has a rich history within the Catholic Church, dating back to the 12th and 13th centuries. Dedicating the month of June to this devotion reminds us of Our Lord's desire through His Heart to enfold us and the whole world in His love and grace, so badly needed in our time. In the Sacred Heart images, we see Our Lord holding out His Heart to us as if to give it wholly and completely to any who would accept It as a source of forgiveness and life. The Church desires her children to grow in this devotion as it bestows many spiritual benefits.

The Ringing of Bells at Mass



In the Roman Rite, handbells were eventually used by altar servers to mark important moments during the Mass. The bells have great spiritual power and alert our senses to what is unfolding before us. They not only draw our attention, they are also a "joyous noise" at the pivotal moments in the Mass when God comes down from Heaven and takes the appearance of bread and wine.

Bells are not meant to be a distraction, but another way to praise God and focus our wandering attention. As the Psalmist sings, "Praise him with sounding cymbals; praise him with loud clashing cymbals! Let everything that breathes praise the Lord! Praise the Lord!" (Psalm 150:5-6)

During the Eucharistic Prayer, the server first rings the bells at the moment when the priest extends his hands over the bread and wine with his palms facing downward – an act of calling upon the Holy Spirit to come down from heaven that is referred to as the "epiclesis." This single ring is meant to draw attention to the proximity of the moment of the consecration.**

Then comes the two sets of three rings: one set at the elevation of the Body of Christ...

...and the other at the elevation of the chalice with the Blood of Christ – calling to attention this moment when Christ literally appears for all to see in the sacrament.**
