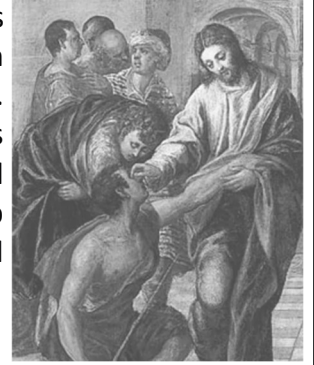

4th Sunday of Lent - Seeing with New Eyes

The Fourth Sunday of Lent brings us stories about seeing in a new way. God helps us look beyond what is on the outside. These readings remind us that God sees people differently than we do. He looks deeper and knows what really matters. In the first reading, David is chosen to be king, even though he is the youngest and smallest. Everyone thought his older brothers would be picked. But God shows that he sees things others miss. The Gospel also tells us about seeing – Jesus heals a man born blind. This healing helps him believe in Jesus. These readings today fit well with Lent, as Lent is a time to grow closer to God. We are asked to let go of things that keep us in the dark. On this Fourth Sunday of Lent, we are invited to open our eyes and trust God to lead us. His ways are full of mercy and light.

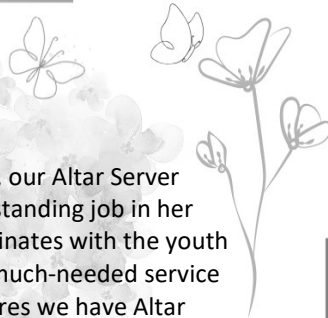
