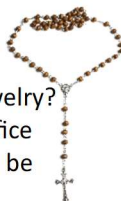

8 WAYS TO PRAY DURING ADORATION

- *Perpetual Adoration* is a Eucharistic devotion in which parishioners unite in pairs, taking hours of Adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament, both during the day and throughout the night, seven days a week.
- At St. George, anyone can adore in the Chapel at any time. **On Thursdays, the Most Blessed Sacrament is exposed from 6AM to 6PM.** It is recommended to have two adorers at a time in case someone needs to leave, so that the Most Blessed Sacrament is not left unattended.
- If you would like to be a *Thursday Adorer*, please call the parish office for chapel code and instructions on reposing or securing the Most Blessed Sacrament should someone not be available to stay when it's your time to leave.
