Are you interested in the opportunity to make new friends? Are you looking for a way to serve your Parish community? Perhaps you may want to consider joining a Guild, either as a full member or a Member-at-Large (attend meetings as able and be kept up-to-date on events). There are three Guilds to choose from at St. Theresa.

St. Anthony of Padua:

The St. Anthony Guild meets the second Monday of each month at 11:00 a.m. in the Pauline Center. This Guild organizes an annual Pot Luck Dinner and an annual Christmas Party, as well as selling raffle tickets at the annual Women's Club Fashion Show and Luncheon. The Guild also makes pillows for the Oncology Department at Northwest Community Healthcare and crochets/knits for Hats of Love. For Pillows, the Guild meets the first Wednesday of each month, from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. in the Pauline Center. For Hats of Love, the Guild meets the third Thursday of each month from 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. in the Pauline Center. All women from all Guilds are welcome to join in these projects.

St. Francis Xavier Guild:

The St. Francis Xavier Guild meets the second Monday of the month, 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. at each other's homes. At each meeting, members read from At Home with the Word and discuss the readings for the upcoming Sunday Mass. These women not only conduct two annual Bake Sales, one in November and one in February, they also organize the Pot O' Gold at the Women's Club Annual Fashion Show and Luncheon.

St. Theresa Guild:

The St. Theresa Guild plans, coordinates and organizes many fundraisers for the Parish, including the annual Women's Club Fashion Show, Salad Luncheon, etc. This Guild meets the second Thursday of each month, August through June, from 7:00 – 8:30 p.m. in the Pauline Center.

Although there are three Guilds comprising St. Theresa Women's Club, we all work together on various events. We are a very social club that enjoy each other's company and look forward to having you join in our fun and excitement.
