About the Canadian Elite Basketball League (CEBL)

The Canadian Elite Basketball League (CEBL) is Canada's professional basketball league, with 10 member clubs across six provinces. Blending global innovation with local connection, the league is redefining how the game is played and experienced while rooting its teams deeply in communities coast to coast. With a fan base of 4.1 million Canadians – up 57 per cent since 2022 – the CEBL has cultivated Canada's youngest basketball audience, with more than half of its fans aged 34 or younger. Its rapid growth reflects its ability to connect authentically with a new generation of basketball fans while expanding the sport's cultural footprint nationwide.

In 2025, the CEBL featured 17 players with NBA experience, and nearly 70 per cent of its athletes were Canadian – the highest proportion of domestic talent in any professional sports league in the country. - Assist in managing transmission/distribution for all CEBL Games (livestream and radio)
- Ongoing gameday content revisions and support for all broadcast partners
- Assist in the distribution of CEBL broadcasts to all necessary streaming partners
- Assist in the creation of scripts for all CEBL non-linear broadcasts using scripting software
- Monitor and track game storylines as they happen for all teams in the league
- Support for key departments including but not limited to; production, operations, marketing, social media, sponsorship
- Assist in the production of studio content
- Help ensure proper content has been distributed to all member teams for in-arena activations and content
- Assist in CEBL shoulder content
- Create and assist with various video editing and graphics editing tasks as assigned
