## FERENBAUGH CAMPGROUND RULES

- Please call 607-962-6193 or call or text 607-329-4342 for assistance during non-office hours.
- \* All site rates are based on 2 adults and dependent children.
- \*YOU MUST BE AGE 21 TO REGISTER FOR A CAMPSITE. There is NO SUBLETTING of campers or sites.
- \*Check In/Out Times: Check in 2:00pm & Check out -1:00pm. Cabins Check in 3:00pm & Check out 1pm
- \*<u>Visitors:</u> <u>All visitors must register in the store</u>. There is a signup sheet at the main desk. Please make your guests aware of this. All visitors must have car passes. The person who is registered to the site must be present when visitors are here. Fee is \$5.00 per person & \$3 per child 12 & under. Visitors must leave by 9:00pm or pay for overnight camping. (\$10.00/ adult, \$5.00/child)
- \*Alcoholic Beverages: Consumption of alcohol is restricted to your own campsite or at the pavilion in moderation. Please do not drink and drive.
- \*Bathrooms/Showers: Please help us keep the restrooms clean by picking up after yourself and your children. Children under 10 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Do not wash dishes, dye clothing or hair in our interior bathroom sinks or showers. Please do not flush sanitary products in the toilet. Please be respectful. Please let us know if a restroom/shower needs our attention!
- \*Water -If you see a water leak or do not have water on your site, please let the main office know as soon as possible. We would really appreciate it.
- \*Electric: If you have an electrical problem, bring it to our attention, let us handle it.
- \*Garbage: Garbage bags are available in the office. Please carry all trash to our dumpsters. We have a recycling dumpster located behind the main building for all cardboard, paper, cans, and plastic.
- \*<u>Do not walk through ANY sites. Occupied sites have video cameras.</u> Do not take any firewood or any other items even if it looks unoccupied!! You will be prosecuted to the fullest extent.
- \*Pets: Must be kept on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pets. Shot/rabies records must be kept with you. Do not leave pets outside on a leash unattended especially if they like to bark.
- \*Waste Water: Dump <u>ALL</u> waste water in our dump station. We have a portable pump that will pump out your black & grey water. This service is \$12 and is offered M/W/F 12am -4pm. and \$25 for an emergency pump. Please sign up for this service at the office the day before.
- \*Protect our trees: Do not cut down trees or branches or destroy them. No nails or screws in trees!
- \*SPEED LIMIT IS 5MPH. PLEASE OBSERVE ON ALL CAMPGROUND ROADS.
- \*Campfires: Build campfires in fireplace or campfire rings. Do not move rings. Do not leave fire unattended!
- \*QUIET HOURS ARE FROM Sunday-Thursday 10pm-9am & Friday & Saturday 11pm-9am
- \*Disorderly conduct, drunkenness, loud music (over 90 decibels), obscene language, fighting, and/or violence will not be tolerated at any hour and will be cause for immediate eviction. Please have respect for your fellow campers.
- \*Firearms/weapons, drugs are strictly prohibited.
- \* Fireworks (NYS Legal) are permitted in designated areas only by the pond or in the field away from campers... not in the woods obviously. Pick up and discard all of your firework debris after it has cooled and put it in the garbage.
- \* AGAIN The speed limit throughout the campground is 5 MPH!!! There are a lot of children here! Please drive slow!!! Seriously.....5-10 mph is all that will be tolerated here! Please and thank you!
- \*Only campers with a valid driver license, or over the age of 18 are permitted to have or operate an ATV/UTV, or golf cart on the campground premises. Only the site holder who is registered to that site and who is the owner of the ATV/UTV & their immediate family members covered by their insurance may operate it on the campground premises. Golf carts are permitted with proof of insurance for overnight campers. No dirt bikes or minibikes, 2 strokes EVER. The camp roads are not meant to be a road track. Please only use when going place to place or go on the trails.
