SCOTTISH RUGBY REFEREES ASSOCIATION (SRRA) PURPOSE OF ASSOCIATION

This paper summarises the purpose of the SRRA as determined by the Rugby Referee Societies.

- To represent the interests of Match Officials (collectively, and where specifically requested by an individual MO, in relation to that MO) specifically, Match Officials who are members of one of the Rugby Referee Societies in Scotland.
- To be the first point of contact for matters of Scottish Rugby policy which will impact the match official community.
- To act as reviewer and consultative body on behalf of the Match Official community.
- To be a single voice representing referee societies in those instances where the SRRA Committee and the referee societies agrees it appropriate.
- To be a strong voice for grass roots refereeing and ensure that this area of the game is not ignored.
- To be a medium for the exchange of good practice amongst the rugby referee societies
- To be a neutral body to act as moderator or mediator between a referee society or societies and the SRU should the societies deem it appropriate and should the need arise.
- To support and preserve the autonomous nature of the rugby referee societies.
