Western Skies Men's Club 2026 Membership Information

Annual Fee: \$115 Renewal Fee (**ONLY IF PAID BY December 31st**)
\$130 New Members

Includes: \$500 Hole in One Club. Anyone who gets a hole in one during a men's club will share the pot for the year.

Fee: Men's Club members are responsible for paying their own green fees. Buy-in is CASH ONLY, \$25 for a 1-day event, \$50 for a 2-day event which covers flight winners & CTP's.

Gross skins, Net skins, side games and Deuces are all separate buy-ins.

Tournaments: Schedule will be set with a minimum of 30 events, sign up deadline is Wednesday night prior to event at pro shop closing. Any member signing up after will be on the wait list. All members play from the designated Men's Club Tee.

Pay Out: Tournament winnings will be in cash.

Player of the Year: Player of the year is based on the number of accumulated points throughout the year (please see the explanation of points below). For the 2-day Points event, both rounds count and there is no throw away as it is the last points of the year. Presidents Cup, Club Championship and Points Championships are double point events

Sign Up and Cancellation Policy: You may sign up for tournaments by replying to the email invitation from the men's club board. The deadline for guaranteed entry is Wednesday night prior to the event. Entry after the deadline is at the discretion of the Golf Shop Staff based on tee time availability. For a Pre-Pay tournament, the Pre-Pay fee is due on or before the entry deadline.

Tee Times: Players may request certain groupings with which they would like to play. Every effort will be made to accommodate these requests. The Men's Club Board, however, has the ultimate authority for pairings, starting holes and may at times modify tee times and pairings as necessary for the smooth operation of our tournaments.

Major Tournaments: The following will be considered major tournaments: President Cup, Club Championship, both 2 Day Calcutta's and the year end points race. Players are required to play in at least three events prior to be eligible to participate in any Major.

Late Penalties: To help speed up play, all participants **can be charged with a two-stroke penalty for being late for their tee time.** The Board will have the responsibility of issuing such penalties. This rule applies to ALL Men's Club events.

Handicaps: See separate sheet for handicap details. HANDICAP CHAIRMAN WILL POST YOUR TOURNAMENT SCORE IN GINN SYSTEM.

Schedule: The Men's Club board has the right to change formats and dates of any tournament.

WESTERN SKIES HANDICAP PROCEDURE

Returning Members:

Your handicap will be based on the best five of the last 6 scores for each tournament.

New Members:

A new member will be required to provide handicap info. AGA, GHIN, SOCIAL, ETC. The first tournament gross and net will be the 5% rule where the new members gross score cannot be lower than info by more than 5%. Example: a 12 handicap cannot shoot, or be credited with for payout purposes, a score of less than 80 gross, 68 net.

Second tournament – same

Third event, with 2 scores recorded, best 1 of 2

Fourth- best 2 of 3,

Fifth- best 3 of 4

Sixth- best 4 of 5

Seventh on- best 5 of last 6 used for all scoring.

A new member will play the first tournament at 80% of the first round. The second tournament will be played at the handicap of your first round with a provision being the lowest net score will be 68 the same as for the new member with a handicap. After that we will be the same as the above.

Third event, best 1 of 2

Fourth- best 2 of 3

Fifth- best 3 of 4

Sixth- best 4 of 5

Seventh- best 5 of last 6 used for all scoring.

Explanation of Points System for 2026

The points system for the 2024 season will be awarded based upon how a player scores in relation to his handicap with a 20-point base. 1 point will be awarded for each stroke below net par and 1 point will be deducted for each stroke above net par.

For example: Handicap is 10 (Net par score = $72 + 10 = 82$)

Score = 69: Points = $20 + 3 = 23$

Score = 84: Points = $20 - 2 = 18$

Each player will have their 2 lowest point's tournament score thrown out from their overall point's total. 0 points is the lowest number of points a player can receive for playing (no player will receive negative points.) The only event not allowed to throw out is the 2nd to last event of the year, if you cannot attend you will receive 0 points.

The top finishers will receive a cash payout (number to be based on how many members we have, but at least the top 10 will receive a payout.)
