RV Technician Interview Checklist

Use this before hiring any RV tech — mobile or shop-based

Credentials & Experience

- ☐ Are you certified through RVTI or RVTAA? What level?
- ☐ How long have you worked on RVs?
- ☐ What systems do you specialize in (roofing, Aqua-Hot, solar, plumbing etc.)?

Repair Approach

- ☐ How would you diagnose this issue?
- ☐ Do you carry parts for this brand/system?
- ☐ What's your process if the issue is more complex than expected?

Past Work & References

- ☐ Can I see photos or reviews from similar jobs?
- ☐ Do you have references I can contact?

Communication & Transparency

- ☐ Do you offer written estimates before starting work?
- ☐ Will you explain the repair steps and materials used?
- ☐ Do you offer a warranty on labor and parts?

Insurance & Protection

- ☐ Are you insured for liability and damage?
- ☐ What happens if something goes wrong after the repair?

Red Flag Filters

- ☐ Would you reuse a roof A/C gasket after lifting the unit?
(Correct answer: No)
- ☐ Do you consider Eternabond tape a permanent fix?
(Correct answer: No—it's a patch)
- ☐ Do you layer new caulk over old without inspecting the soft spot?
(Correct answer: No)
