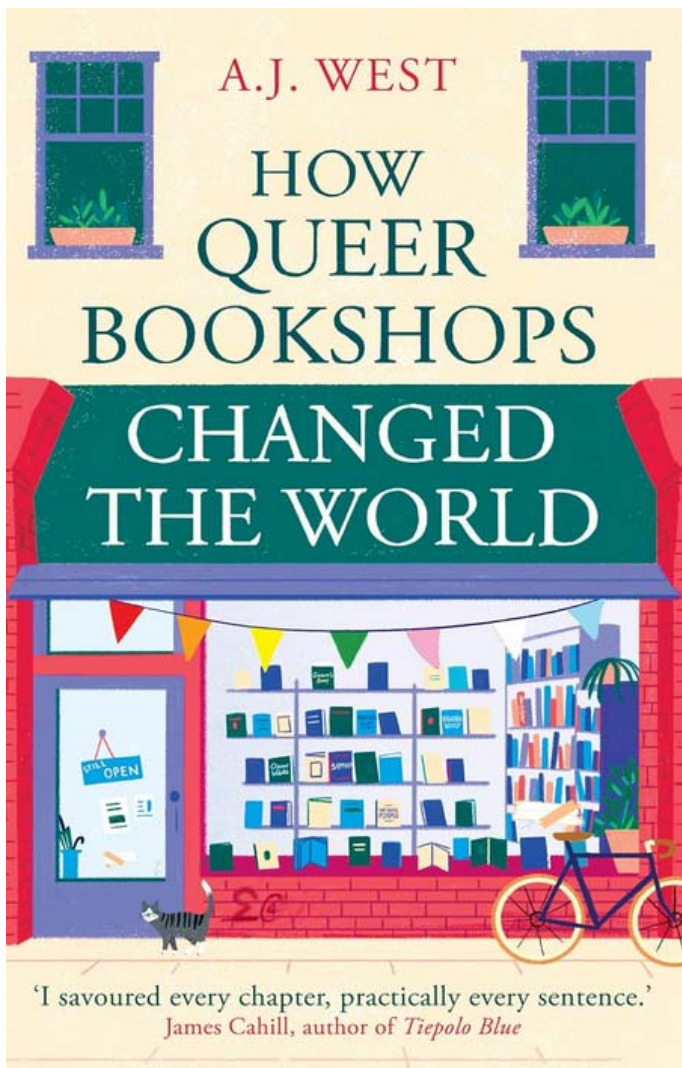

The remarkable tale of how queer bookshops built communities, nourished minds, redefined literature – and changed the world

For over a century, LGBTQ+ bookshops have been the unsung heroes of queer liberation

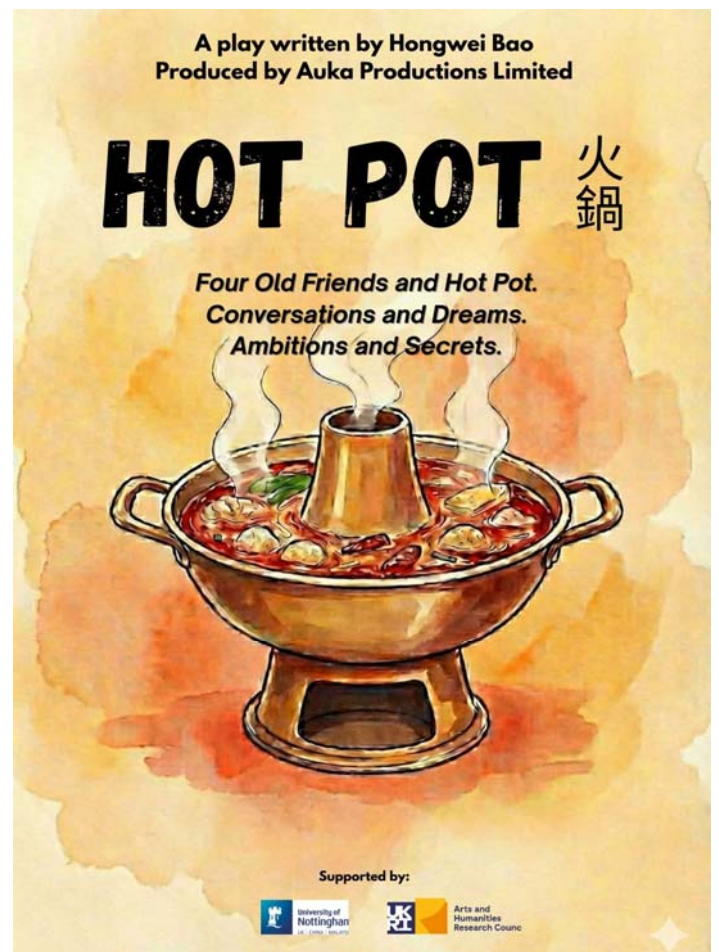
Home not only to books but chaotic community noticeboards and vicious rescue cats, queer bookshops have always been more than just bookshops, offering friendship, solidarity and sanctuary.

Travelling the world – Shakespeare and Company in Paris, Gay's the Word in London, the Oscar Wilde Bookshop in New York – A. J. West explores the remarkable history of these bookstores.

Tracing their evolution from under-the-counter operations to beloved out-and-proud institutions, West reveals how the queer bookshop stood at the vanguard of LGBTQ+ rights, offering support and vital information through the AIDS crisis and bringing the fight to Section 28 and book bans.
