Personal Independence Payment

- ◆ Personal Independence Payment is a benefit you may be able to claim if you need help with your everyday life or if you need help with getting around, and the reason you need the help is due to physical or mental disability/illness
- ◆ Personal Independence Payment isn't means tested which means you can have a high income and/or savings and this will not affect eligibility
- ◆ You need to be 16 or over and under state pension age when you first make a claim.
- ◆ You don't need someone caring for you to qualify—it is about the help you need, not the help you get
- ◆ Personal Independence Payment isn't taxable and can be paid on top of your current income
- ◆ If Personal Independence Payment is awarded, it can continue to be paid for as long as you are eligible, even if you reach state pension age or over
