2. CPR office staff will contact the primary contact in order to schedule an interview promptly after applying.
3. Interviews will take place at the Clinton Parks & Recreation Office prior to May 1st, 2026.
4. Selected applicants will be asked to return to pick up their acceptance letters and summer schedules prior to May 29th, 2026.

Program Details:

- If admitted, participants in our Teen Leadership Program will attend our program Monday, Wednesday & Friday and act as a CIT at our Summer Discovery

program, and Tuesday & Thursday will attend our Teen Adventure program for the field trip days.

- Spaces are limited to 5 teen leadership participants per week in order to accommodate program capacities and staffing requirements.
- Application to this program is completely optional, and in no way required for enrollment in Teen Adventure. Teen Adventure is a program open to children entering 6th-9th grade in which they are full time participants in our program.
- Applicants must be entering 8th Grade in the Fall of 2026 and must follow all Summer Programming Policy and Procedure. No exceptions.
- Please note, that while this is a volunteer opportunity, it does differ in structure from our CIT program and does not count as "CIT" participation.
- If admitted, a \$50.00/week fee will be required for participation in the program.
