ITEMIZED SELECTIONS

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean that you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. Minnesota law states this also applies to funeral goods, funeral services, burial site goods and burial site services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff\$2,150

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; shelter of remains; placement of obituary notices; planning of funeral arrangements; and coordination of service with cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.) Minnesota law states: (This fee is already included in our charges for alkaline hydrolysis, direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

Embalming\$1,750

FTC: Except in certain special cases, Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

MN: Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available.

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home

This charge includes transfer of remains, necessary services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, and local transportation (but not shipping charges). This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.

Receiving of Remains from Another Funeral Home

This charge includes temporary shelter of remains, transportation of remains to cemetery and necessary services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies.

Immediate Burial.....Not Offered

Direct Cremation\$2,485 – \$5,935

Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes basic services of licensed funeral directors and staff; removal of remains; transportation to crematory; necessary authorizations; and cremation. Our price for direct cremation includes the crematory fee.

FTC: If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide range from heavy cardboard to fiberboard or light wood veneer materials.

MN: Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide range from heavy cardboard to fiberboard or light wood veneer materials.
