Bible Study – 2 Timothy 1:1-18

Read the Bible verse above from your Bible or from the presentation. Answer the questions below after meditating on the verses.

Paul highlights the sincere faith passed down from Lois to Eunice to Timothy (v. 5).

- How has faith been handed on to you – positivity or imperfectly – what kind of faith legacy do you hope to pass on to your children?

Paul encourages Timothy to “fan into flame” the gift God has given him (vv. 6-7).

- As parents, what gifts do you see God placing in your children, and how can you intentionally help nurture those gifts with courage rather than fear?

Paul reminds Timothy not to be ashamed of the Gospel, even when it involves sacrifice (v. 8).

- What are some challenges parents face today in living and modeling the faith at home, and how can we support one another in choosing faith over fear?
