## **Saints**

Saints are the heroes of the Catholic faith. They lived in holiness, dedicated to serving God and spreading His message of salvation. Many Catholic saints courageously met their deaths simply because of their faith. Today the saints serve as examples for all Catholics, showing us how to lead a more satisfying spiritual life in communion with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. They are reminders that this life will come to an end, and only what was done for Christ will have a lasting reward. Each saint's story is a fascinating one. They lived at different times in different places throughout history, but they all shared a love of God that has been meticulously documented through the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Choosing a saint name is an essential part of Confirmation and it is an acknowledgement that the Holy Spirit will change you through the grace of this Sacrament. We see in Scripture that Jesus changed the name of some of his disciples to signify that their role had been changed and that they were becoming, in a sense, a new person. For example, Abram became Abraham (Genesis 17:5), Sarai became Sarah (Genesis 17:15), and Simon became Peter (Matthew 16:18).

When choosing a saint, you should choose someone who exemplifies a quality that you wish to have, somebody whose life you want to emulate, or somebody you find fits your personality or spiritual goals. You should also be asking for the prayers and intercession of the saint that you choose. When you choose a saint, and begin to pray for their intercession, he/she becomes your patron saint for the rest of your life and will help you to seek a closer relationship with God.

## Santos

Los santos son héroes de la fe católica. Ellos vivieron en santidad, se dedicaron a servir a Dios y a difundir Su mensaje de salvación. Muchos Santos católicos enfrentaron su muerte valientemente simplemente por su fe. Hoy los santos sirven de ejemplo para todos los católicos mostrándonos como llevar una vida espiritual más satisfactoria en comunión con nuestro Señor y Salvador, Cristo Jesus. Ellos nos recuerdan que esta vida llegara a su fin y solo lo que se hizo por Cristo tendrá una recompensa duradera. La historia de cada Santo es fascinante. Ellos vivieron en diferentes tiempos y en diferentes lugares atreves de la historia, pero todos comparten el amor de Dios que ha sido meticulosamente documentada en las enseñanzas de la Iglesia Católica.

Elegir el nombre de un Santo es parte esencial de la Confirmación y es un reconocimiento de que el Espíritu Santo te cambiará a través de la gracia de este Sacramento. Vemos en las escrituras que JESUS cambio el nombre de algunos de sus discípulos para indicar que su papel había cambiado y que se estaban convirtiendo, en cierto sentido, y en una nueva persona. Por ejemplo, Abram se convirtió en Abraham (Genesis 17:5), Saraí se convirtió en Sarah (Genesis 17:15), y Simón se convirtió en Peter/Pedro (Matthew 16:18).

*Cuando elijas a un Santo, elije a alguien que tenga una cualidad ejemplar que deseas tener, alguien cuya vida quieras imitar o que se parezca a ti en, personalidad y metas espirituales. También debes pedir las oraciones y la intercesión del Santo que elijas. Él/Ella se convierten en tu Santo patrón por el resto de tu vida y te ayudará a buscar una relación más cercana con Dios.*
