The focus is to develop growth as a disciple who can generously identify and respond to the needs of others.

Jesus taught this principle over 2000 years ago! In his Parable of the Last Judgement, Jesus made it abundantly clear that faith in him will be judged by how well that faith was put into action: Then the righteous will answer him, "Lord, when did we see thee hungry and feed thee, or thirsty and give thee drink? When did we see thee a stranger and welcome thee or naked and clothe thee? When did we see thee sick or in prison and visit thee? And the King will answer them, "Truly I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me." Matthew 25:37-40. It is within this spirit that is an essential characteristic of Christian discipleship rather than completing an absolute number of hours.

The Corporal Works of Mercy are 7 specific ways in which we can help our "neighbors" by showing them God's love and mercy:

To feed the hungry;

To give drink to the thirsty;

To clothe the naked:

To shelter the homeless;
