NARRATIVE REPORT ON FINANCIAL POSITION/FBCSP

June 2025 vs June 2024

Through the first six months of 2025 we received \$663,151 in budget contributions, \$4,149 more than our giving goal of \$659,002. In 2024 our receipts were \$669,090, \$5,939 more than in the current year. The church's operating cash flow increased in the second quarter of 2025, receipts exceeding expenses by \$65,658.

The balance of our General Endowment Fund as of June 30, 2025, was \$487,642. The Jeannie H. Jordan Memorial Endowment for the benefit of Sonshine Learning Center had a balance of \$92,394 and helps fund scholarships during the school year. The Memorial Youth Fund had a balance of \$130,087.

Ministry of Missions Update: During the second quarter of 2025, your dollars supported CBF Missionaries - Carson & Laura Foushee, Sandhills/Moore Coalition for Human Care, Cameron Boys' Camp and Camp Duncan for Girls, Moore Free Care Clinic, Carthage Food Pantry, Team Workz, We Care Food Pantry, CROP Hunger Walk and provided rental assistance, food and gas cards for those in need in our community. We also supported those affected by Hurricane Helene by sending adult and middle school mission teams to Western NC. College and High School students went to Florida on mission trips in May and June. We purchased items and packed "Blessing Bags" during our churchwide picnic in May and assisted a college student with their mission trip to El Salvador. The Annie Armstrong Easter and CBF Global Missions Easter Offerings goal for 2025 was \$6,000; we collected \$6,753. We also supported Baptists on Mission and the WMU of NC

TRANSFORMING LIVES THROUGH KAIROS PRISON MINISTRY - SEPTEMBER 18-21

Our church has a vibrant partnership with the Kairos Prison Ministry at Scotland Correctional Institution, Laurinburg, through generous financial gifts from our Mission Committee and Sunday School classes, heartfelt prayers, and meaningful Agape items.

Our training begins August 14th. I will be serving as the leader for this mission outreach. We are seeking your prayers for sufficient volunteers to minister to at least 30 inmates. The Inside Team facilitates the structured 3.5-day program. The Support Team presents the donated meals from various sources and offers essential logistical assistance. Those who have served consistently share how deeply enjoyable and rewarding their experience was, witnessing the profound spiritual impact on the inmates.

The event culminates in a moving closing ceremony where graduates share their transformative experiences and how God has touched their lives. We continue to uplift these men in prayer and encourage their participation in our weekly Wednesday evening Prayer and Share meetings.
