NOTES OF GRATITUDE

To my Fellow Church Members,

I have been thinking of the mission minded church family that I have at First Baptist Church of Southern Pines. I am so thankful Family Promise of Moore County (FPMC) is one of the many organizations that this church serves in its Mission Outreach. I just need to share a little with everyone about some of the mission work that some church members may not know about.

We are one of FPMC's rotational partner churches. That means that approximately every 11 weeks, this church takes on the responsibility for bringing dinner for families staying in the shelter and volunteers spend the night at the shelter with the families Monday – Thursday of that week. In fact, we were one of the "founding" rotational churches participating when FPMC started 24 years ago, and at that time the families were spending the nights in the partner churches. So many volunteers and coordinators, some still active from the beginning and our mission of serving families experiencing homelessness is going strong at the FPMC shelter house. (The church has a bulletin board with more information on this mission volunteer opportunity!

FPMC also recently benefited from an Operation Inasmuch crew that came to the shelter and did some deep cleaning. Cleaning every home needs at least once a year – drawers, doors, cabinets, shelves, and air return grille covers to name a few things. I know there were many OIAM volunteers serving in our community that day, but I have to say I am especially thankful for a brighter, cleaner shelter house after 4 hours of cleaning! We also are thankful for the cleaning supplies and shelter supplies that you left with us. Cleaning is always ongoing with up to four families at a time in the shelter!

A few weeks ago, our church had deacon ordination. As I sat and heard about service and for our deacons to be leaders in service – it brought tears to my eyes and thankfulness to my heart. What I knew as I listened that morning was, the deacon leading the charge, a deacon that was being ordained and a deacon that was returning to serve, already planned to meet me later that afternoon for furniture moving. These three men and several others in our church are a group that I can call on, to help a mother with moving furniture when the family moves into their new home after being in the shelter.

They also help if we receive small furniture donations for future family needs, or if a mother needs to save any furniture the family may have when they are coming into the shelter.

Thank you to my church family for all you do in your mission of service at Family Promise of Moore County and for making a difference in the lives of the families we serve!
