


The Riggsbee's Mission Trip Report

KAIROS PRISON MINISTRY UPDATE



Our church proudly supports the Kairos Prison Ministry at the Scotland Correctional Institution in Laurinburg. This facility houses 1800 inmates with a staff of 550 and 1 chaplain who retires at the end of January. Our next major Inside Event is rapidly approaching, February 26-March 1, 2026. During this intensive program, we guide 30 inmate participants on a journey of discovering Christ's love. Following the Inside Event, our ministry continues with Wednesday evening "Prayer and Share" sessions. Led by Kairos graduates, these gatherings foster prayer, fellowship, and support, aiming to improve the lives and environment within the prison. 




