



Fall HVAC Maintenance Checklist

As temperatures start to drop, fall is the perfect time to prep your HVAC system for the colder months. Use this checklist to keep your home cozy and your system in top shape.

- 1 Schedule a professional heating tune-up to inspect and clean the system.
- 2 Replace air filters to improve airflow and indoor air quality.
- 3 Test your thermostat and switch to heating mode before the first cold front.
- 4 Inspect and clear debris from around the outdoor unit or heat pump.
- 5 Check and seal air leaks around windows and doors.
- 6 Clean supply and return vents and make sure they're unobstructed.
- 7 Inspect carbon monoxide detectors and replace batteries if needed.
- 8 Flush the condensate drain line to prevent clogs or overflow.
- 9 Check the pilot light or ignition system on your furnace.
- 10 Review your system's energy usage and consider a smart thermostat upgrade.
