



Summer HVAC Maintenance Checklist

- 1 Schedule a professional tune-up to inspect, clean, and optimize system performance.
- 2 Replace or clean your air filter to improve airflow and energy efficiency.
- 3 Set your thermostat to cooling mode and test it for proper operation.
- 4 Remove leaves, grass, and debris from around the outdoor unit to ensure clear airflow.
- 5 Inspect refrigerant lines for proper insulation and check for leaks.
- 6 Clean dust and debris from supply and return vents throughout the house.
- 7 Test your system on a warm day to make sure it's cooling as expected.
- 8 Seal gaps around windows and doors to prevent cool air from escaping.
- 9 Check the condensate drain line and pan for clogs or standing water.
- 10 Listen for unusual noises that could indicate worn parts or electrical issues.
