

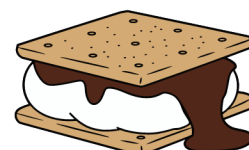
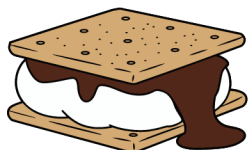


Host a Campfire & S'mores Night



1. **Gather People**

- Start with prayer - ask God who you should invite and pray for open ears and hearts.
- Invite neighbors, friends, or coworkers—anyone you'd love to get to know better.
- Keep it casual: "Hey, I'm making a fire and s'mores this weekend—want to join?"



2. **Set the Fire**

- Pick up firewood at Oakdale's fire pit.
- Build a safe campfire, bring out the s'mores kit, and enjoy the warmth.

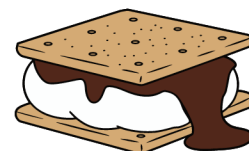
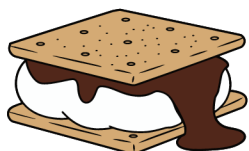
3. **Spark Conversation**

- Begin light: share fun stories, laugh, enjoy the moment.
- Then, ask open-ended questions that invite depth:
 - What's bringing you joy lately?
 - What challenges have you been walking through?
 - Where do you find hope when life feels heavy?



4. **Point Toward Jesus**

- Listen well and share authentically from your own faith.
- Ask discovery questions:
 - Have you ever thought about where God fits in your story?
 - What do you think Jesus is really like?
 - Would you want to explore His story together sometime?



5. **Trust God with the Results**

- Your role: create space, ask questions, love well.
- God's role: ignite hearts and draw people to Himself.
