1. Gather People

- a. Start with prayer ask God who you should invite and pray for open ears and hearts.
- b. Invite neighbors, friends, or coworkers—anyone you'd love to get to know better.
- c. Keep it casual: "Hey, I'm making a fire and s'mores this weekend—want to join?"

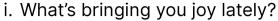


2. Set the Fire

- a. Begin light: share fun stories, laugh, enjoy the moment.
- b. Then, ask open-ended questions that invite depth:



- ii. What challenges have you been walking through?
- iii. Where do you find hope when life feels heavy?



- a. Listen well and share authentically from your own faith.
- b. Ask discovery questions:
 - iii. Would you want to explore His story together sometime?



- a. Your role: create space, ask questions, love well.
- b. God's role: ignite hearts and draw people to Himself.
