To apply, businesses need to:

- Log in (for existing users) or register (for new users) on the Digital Ready platform using the following link: https://digitalready.verizonwireless.com/?utm_source=florida-sbdc-network&utm_medium=partner&utm_campaign=digital-ready_local-partner_miami
- Complete any combination of 2 courses or events between **October 1, 2025, and December 10, 2025**.
- Once eligible, complete the application that you will be sent.

Note that even if the business applied before, new applications must be submitted for each round. Verizon is continually updating videos, events, and content on the site. So past users can reconnect and check out the new content. More information is available via the FAQs site [here](#).

This grant opportunity closes **December 10**, and all award notifications will be sent by the week of January 12, but small businesses are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.
