Hello, my name is Jacob Means, a seminarian for the Diocese of Reno. I've been a seminarian for two years and currently study at Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon. I was born and raised in Winnemucca, Nevada, and have one sibling who attends UNR.

I was born into the faith, and it was here in Nevada that I first heard the Lord's calling to become a priest. My mom tells me I first thought about it in kindergarten! Later, while studying social science at Great Basin College, I originally wanted to become a high school teacher. However, a deeper, undeniable desire for priesthood began to reemerge in my life. During this time, I began to attend Eucharistic adoration more consistently, and it was in the quiet presence of the Lord that I truly felt affirmed in my decision to pursue seminary formation. I am especially drawn to the sacraments and the privilege of guiding people closer to Christ.

I have about five years left in my studies until (God willing) I am ordained a priest, and I couldn't be more excited to see where the Lord will lead me. This summer, I'm blessed to be in Reno and will be interning at the Diocesan Chancery. I'm also very eager to learn from your pastor and experience parish life firsthand here. Please keep me in your prayers as I stay with you for the summer and return to the seminary in August. I am truly looking forward to getting to know your vibrant community for these next two months!

On December 10, 1925, Our Lady promised Sister Lucia (one of the Fatima seers) that she would "...assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturdays of five consecutive months" ...

- Go to confession
- Receive Holy Communion
- · Pray the Rosary
- Meditate on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary

The Intention

To console the Immaculate Heart of Mary, offer reparation for the blasphemies and ingratitude of unrepentant sinners, and for peace in the world.

The Reasons for the First Saturday Devotion

On May 29, 1930, Our Lord explained to Sister Lucia why five first Saturdays. "My daughter, the reason is simple. Against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, five kinds of offenses and blasphemies are committed:

- Those committed against the Immaculate Conception;
- · Those committed against the virginity of Our Lady;
- Those committed against the Divine maternity, refusing at the same time, to accept her as the Mother of men;
- Those committed by men who publicly attempt to instill indifference, scorn and even hatred for this Immaculate Mother in the hearts of children;
- Those committed by men who insult her directly in her statues."




