On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, “Peace be with you.” When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.”

Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, “We have seen the Lord.” But he said to them, “Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and my hand into his side, I will not believe.”

Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked and stood in their midst and said, “Peace be with you.” Then he said to Thomas, “Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving but believe.” Thomas answered and said to him, “My Lord and my God!” Jesus said to him, “have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.” Now, Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.

ST ALBERT THE GREAT CATHOLIC COMMUNITY

Sister Saint Faustina Kowalska was born in Poland in 1905. She had only three years of schooling and worked as a domestic servant before entering the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in 1925. She lived just 13 years as a nun and died of tuberculosis in 1938 at the age of 33. Even though her life was short and simple, Jesus chose her to share an important message with the world—the message of Divine Mercy. In her *Diary*, she wrote that Jesus appeared to her several times between 1930 and 1938, asking her to remind people of God’s great love and mercy.

On February 22, 1931, Jesus appeared to her wearing a white garment, with red and pale rays coming from His heart. He told her: **“Paint an image according to what you see, with the words: “Jesus, I trust in you.”** Jesus promised her that whoever honors this image will not perish. Later, an artist painted this image under her guidance.

Jesus also asked that a special feast be dedicated to Divine Mercy. In 2000, Pope John Paul II established the Feast of Divine Mercy on the Second Sunday of Easter. On this day, Jesus promises great grace and forgiveness to those who trust in Him: **“Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.”**

As we celebrate this feast, let us turn to the Lord with trust, ask for His mercy, and strive to become missionaries of mercy.

Divine Mercy Prayer Service will be held on April 12 at 3PM. Please join us as we come together in prayer and receive the special blessings of the Lord.

Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: To commemorate the 250th anniversary of our nation’s founding, the bishops of the United States will collectively consecrate our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. According to our diocesan guidelines, we will pray the consecration prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus at every Mass, immediately following the 30 seconds of sacred silence after receiving Holy Communion. This will begin on April 12, 2026, and continue through July 5, 2026.

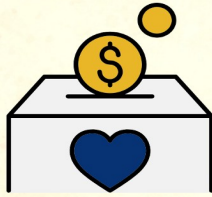

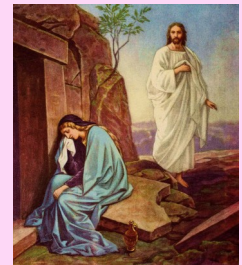
