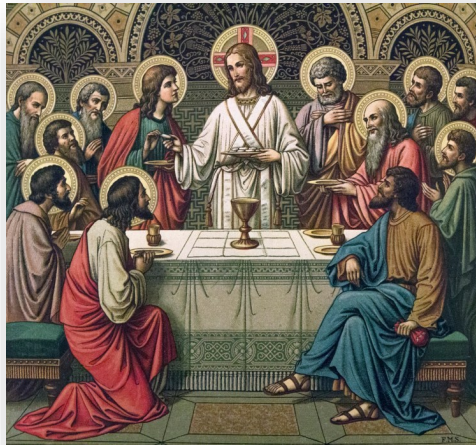

PONDER THIS

“For our fathers, water flowed from the rock; for you, blood flows from Christ.”

St. Ambrose



At the sight of the crowds, Jesus’ heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.”

Then he summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits to drive them out and to cure every disease and every illness. The names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James, the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddeus; Simon from Cana, and Judas Iscariot who betrayed him.

Jesus sent out these twelve after instructing them thus, “Do not go into pagan territory or enter a Samaritan town. Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, make this proclamation: ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give.”

Reverence in Church and in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament

The Second Vatican Council, in Lumen Gentium (11), teaches that the Eucharist is the “source and summit of the Christian life.”

It is the source because all grace comes from Christ, who is truly present in the Eucharist.

It is the summit because it is our highest form of worship, where we join in Christ’s sacrifice to the Father at every Mass. Because of this great gift, we are called to show reverence for the Eucharist in our thoughts, words, and actions.

Ways We Show Reverence

Whether you are a lifelong Catholic or visiting for the first time, you are welcome here. We invite you to enter this sacred space with us in a spirit of prayer, reverence, and openness to the presence of Jesus.

Silence

When we enter the church, we enter a sacred space. Quiet helps us become aware that we are in the presence of God. We should exit the same way and engage in quiet conversation in the narthex.

Modesty

Our clothing should reflect dignity and respect. We dress not for ourselves, but for the Lord who is truly present.

Genuflection

We genuflect toward the tabernacle as a sign of reverence for Christ, our King, present in the Eucharist.

Kneeling

When able, kneeling is a natural posture of adoration. It expresses both God’s greatness and our dependence on Him.

Prayer

Reverence begins in the heart. In the quiet of the church, we speak to the Lord and listen. Silence is not empty—it is where God speaks.

Sign of the Cross

Make it slowly and with intention, remembering the Holy Trinity and the saving Cross of Christ.

Silent Adoration

Spend time simply being with the Lord—looking upon Him with love and faith.

Thanksgiving

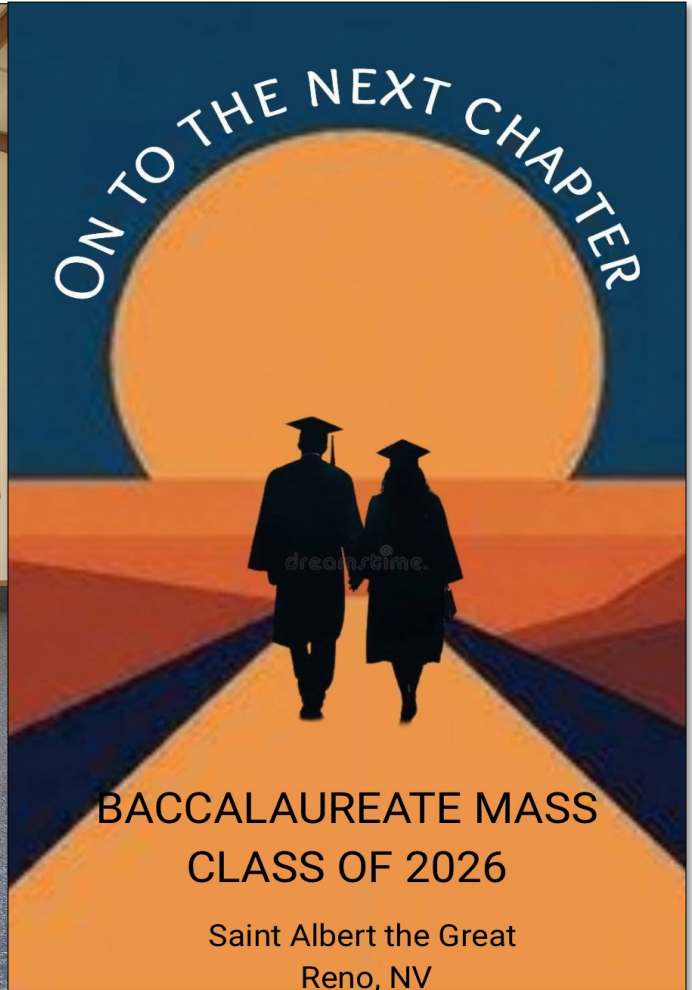
After receiving Communion, remain for a few moments to thank and adore the Lord.

Respect for the Eucharist

We show great care for the Eucharist, even the smallest particle, because Christ is fully present. Everything we do in church should reflect one simple truth: **we are in the presence of Jesus.**

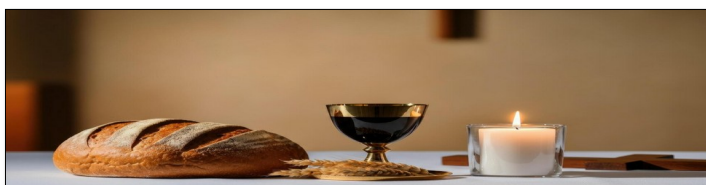

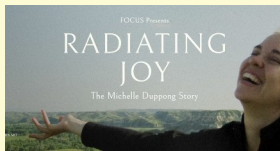
