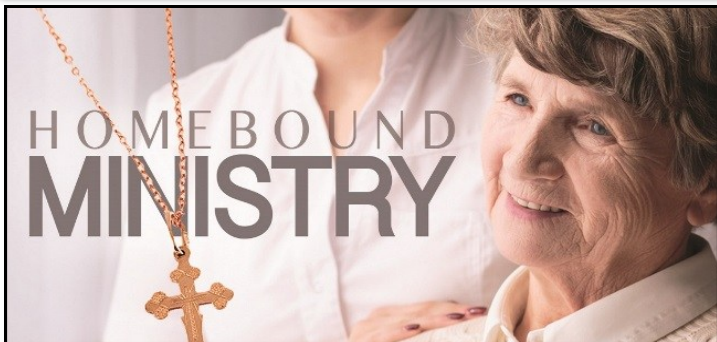
A Post-Abortion Healing Ministry

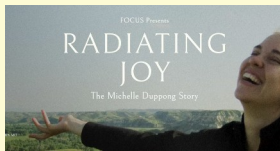
