When Jesus heard of the death of John the Baptist, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself. The crowds heard of this and followed him on foot from their towns. When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, and he cured their sick. When it was evening, the disciples approached him and said, “This is a deserted place and it is already late; dismiss the crowds so that they can go to the villages and buy food for themselves.” Jesus said to them, “There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves.” But they said to him, “Five loaves and two fish are all we have here.” Then he said, “Bring them here to me,” and he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing, broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, who in turn gave them to the crowds. They all ate and were satisfied, and they picked up the fragments left over—twelve wicker baskets full. Those who ate were about five thousand men, not counting women and children.

“THE 4TH ON 4TH”



On the 4th of July 2026, the City of Reno held their annual 4th of July Parade on 4th Street.

Christ the King Council 7322 from Saint Albert the Great Catholic Church in Reno was asked if they could help with a fundraiser before the parade began. The purpose of the event was to serve a complimentary breakfast to anyone who showed up and raise charitable funds for the Veterans Guest House in Reno. The General Manager of the Gold Dust West and Gold 'N Silver Inn, Matt Denning, asked the former owner of the Inn (a Council 7322 Knight) if he knew anyone who had experience with breakfast buffet service. Council 7322 has been organizing, cooking, and serving a monthly parish breakfast for more than two decades – so they certainly had the experience. On the morning of July 4th, Knights from Council 7322 showed up with enthusiasm to help prepare, serve, and clean up at the Breakfast Buffet Extravaganza. The Knights provided 120+ community volunteer hours that day. In approximately three hours, over 300 people were served. Families, community leaders, first responders, and veterans attended. In addition to supporting the re-opening of a historic and important local business, more than \$7,600 in charitable donations were collected for the Veterans Guest House.

This Independence Day event was truly a testimony of Brothers rallying together in Chairty, Unity, Fraternity, and Patriotism to make a difference.

On July 16th, Council Knights, together with Matt Denning, presented a check from the donations collected to Mrs. Patrice Klaich, Director of Development for the Veterans Guest House.

This event was well received by the public. It was a resounding success. Council members agreed this should be an annual occurrence. We are now discussing the possibility of doing the same at the Veterans Day Parade in Reno, Nevada. Come and join us if you are in town!!

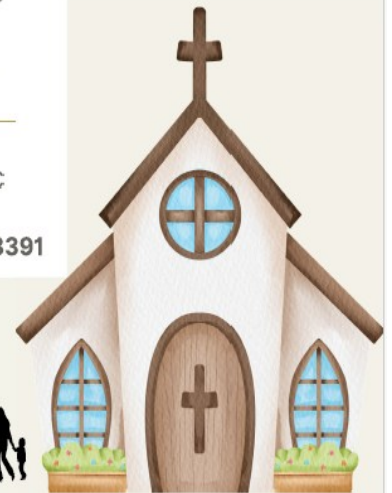

(Diocese of Reno-moved to Sunday, May 17th)

Sunday, November 1: All Saints' Day

Tuesday, December 8: The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Friday, December 25: Christmas (Nativity of the Lord)

Note: The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15) is not a holy day of obligation in 2026 because it falls on a Saturday.

Preparing for Infant Baptism

Children who are not yet of catechetical age (generally, under 8 years old) are happily brought to the Church by their parents for the Sacrament of Baptism. The Sacrament of Baptism is the initial gift of faith given by God, beginning the child's faith life and making him/her a child of God. At least one parent must be a Catholic member of the parish and practicing the Catholic Faith. At least one Catholic godparent is required to act as a witness to the Baptism and companion with the parents in raising the child in our Catholic Faith. If two godparents are chosen, both must be practicing Catholics; one female and one male. The parents and godparent(s) must attend one Pre-Baptismal Preparation class and meet with the Pastor before the Baptism can be scheduled. In exceptional cases, if the parents are asking for Baptism at St. Albert's, but worship at another parish, parents must meet St. Albert's requirements and bring a letter of permission from their pastor. If the godparents are not members of St. Albert's, they must meet St. Albert's requirements for godparents OR bring proof that they have met the requirements for godparents of their parish and complete the Godparent Verification Form. We look forward to celebrating your child's Baptism. Classes for Baptism Preparation are held the 3rd Saturday of each month (pre-registration is not necessary).

Beginning in Advent 2026, ALL infant Baptisms are scheduled at week-end Masses, during the Celebration of the Eucharist.

Children of catechetical age (8 years old and above) who are un-baptized may attend a Sacramental Preparation process for two years and will be eligible to be fully initiated; Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.
