ST. ALBERT'S WINE IN THE BIBLE

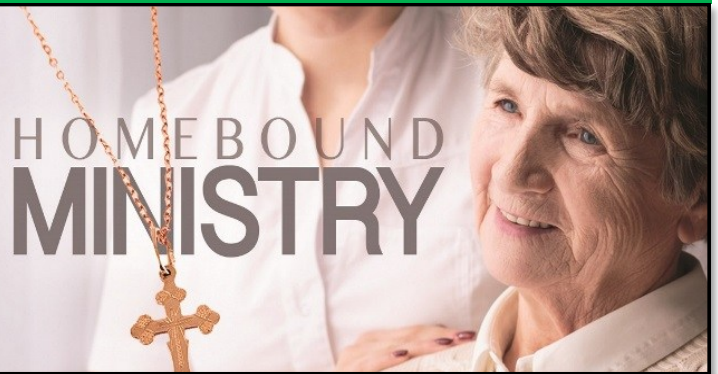

Friday, December 25: Christmas (Nativity of the Lord)
