Experience the Precious Marine Heritage – WWF Hoi Ha Marine Life Centre

You are cordially invited to join a marine education programme – Experience the Precious Marine Heritage, at Hoi Ha Marine Life Centre

Hoi Ha Marine Life Centre

The Centre is the only sea-based marine education centre in Hong Kong which has been providing interactive marine education programmes.

This visit will provide an opportunity for you to explore the coastal environment and underwater world in the Hoi Ha Wan Marine Park. Hoi Ha Wan was designated as one of Hong Kong's first marine parks in July 1996 which has a rich marine biodiversity where more than 60 coral species have been recorded. This is comparable to the Caribbean Sea! There are also two 100-year old lime kilns situated at Hoi Ha Wan which reflect its cultural heritage.

Activity

- Lime kiln introduction
- Plankton observation
- Glass-bottomed Boat trip
- Game – Sustainability theme

Programme Duration: 3 hours

All participants must be aged 5 or above
