Dutch ZuiveINL: (EXW Factory): **dd 22-10-25** Butter down 5330 >>5150mt, FCMP down 3610/mt >>3580/mt, SMP food down 2120/mt >>2060/mt, SMP feed bulk down 2100 >>2070/mt and SWP in Bulk for feed is up 940>>970/mt.

SWP for feed in Bulk DAP NL: Firm(ing) further: €960-€1000/MT feed and food increased as well above €1050/MT.

Whey concentrate: prices around €350-€550/MT FCA (still fighting against cheap SMC on the drying towers)

Skimmed concentrate: we hear prices above €1000/MT , average between €1200-€1300/MT FCA (slightly up)

SMP food: Offered prices euro 1975-2050/MT and FEED SMP is stable around €2000-€2050/MT

Cream: Prices increased towards prices above 6 again: €6000-€6200/MT... with some at levels around €5900/MT FCA

Butter: Dutch/Belgium/German at €4900-€5100/MT (French and Irish are sold below these levels: €4650-€4900/MT FCA). Q1 and Q2 2025 prices are done at levels above

Cheese: We see Gouda/Mozzarella prices stabilizing at levels around €2800/MT (€2750-€2850/MT), with some close-by demand. Cheddar is still under pressure: €3350-€3450/MT for Curd

Milk: Unchanged situation: Plenty of milk available and spot prices stay under pressure. We do read slaughtering of older cows has started to increase...

GDT-Event 390 dd 21-10-25: Down -1.4%: NZ milk intake is up 2.5% till sept (YTD). **Imports of China** YTD August look good: WMP 322.020MT = up 3% and Cheese 128.862MT = up 13% and SMP is down 3% 163.880MT. Whey up 13% 463.267MT
