HEALTH POLICY REMINDER.....

If your child is sent home with a fever of 101 or higher, they may return when fever-free for 24 hours without medication. We will determine if a sibling needs to go home on a case-by-case basis, depending on the severity of symptoms and/or illness.

Regarding COVID-19, if someone tests positive, we will follow the CDC guidelines, which state that individuals with COVID-19 can return to normal activities when symptoms have improved for at least 24 hours and there is no fever, even without taking fever-reducing medication like acetaminophen or ibuprofen. If there is a spike in cases, we will return to the 5 day quarantine policy.

Diarrhea – If your child has two loose stools, we will call you to have your child dismissed. They may return after 24 hours without any loose stools. Conjunctivitis—If we notice any signs of conjunctivitis, we will call you to dismiss your child. He or she can return once he or she has been on the prescribed medication for 24 hours.

Lunch Program Update

We greatly appreciate your understanding regarding our recent decision to discontinue the lunch program. While we recognize how convenient this service was for everyone, the increasing costs and the amount of waste made it too difficult for us to continue. As a reminder, our center is nut-free to ensure the safety of all children.
