### HEALTH POLICY REMINDER.....

If your child is sent home with a fever of 101 or higher, they may return when fever-free for 24 hours without medication. We will determine if a sibling needs to go home on a case-by-case basis, depending on the severity of symptoms and/or illness.

Diarrhea – If your child has two loose stools, we will call you to have your child dismissed. They may return after 24 hours without any loose stools.  
Conjunctivitis—If we notice any signs of conjunctivitis, we will call you to dismiss your

child. He or she can return once he or she has been on the prescribed medication for 24 hours.
