20		Côtes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Rouge, Jean-Luc Colombo France Fresh and silky on the palate, the aromas of small red fruits follow through, prolonged by notes of liquorice and spice. BRONZE (2015) INTERNATIONAL WINE CHALLENGE 2017 <i>Meaning ‘the bees’, Les Abeilles reflects the passion the Colombo family has for the habitat a round their Cornas vineyards.
