## CERTIFIED COPIES OF THE DEATH CERTIFICATE

The original certificate of death is filed in the county where the death occurred. While certificate copies of the original may be purchased at any time from the county recorder, we can order any number of copies you may anticipate. The cost is \$13.00 for the first copy and \$6.00 per copy thereafter. The county also charges \$5.00 to mail the certified copies.

Please be aware that the funeral home's portion of the death certificate is completed within 24 hours of meeting the funeral director. It has been our experience that the attending physician may take two to three weeks to sign their portion of the death certificate before certified copies of the death certificate may be available from the county recorders office.

NOTE: The Social Security Administration may or may not require a certified copy of the death certificate, as the funeral home is required to notify them with the SSA-721 form.

<u>Certified Cause of Death Certificate</u> – A certified death certificate (fact and cause of death), is usually required by life insurance companies. These are the standard certificates that we order after a death. Cost is \$13.00 for the first and \$6 for each additional when ordered at the same time.

<u>Certified Fact of Death Certificate</u> – Certified fact of death certificates may be purchased immediately upon filing, allowing the family or personal representative to begin the process of estate settlement. This process might include closing bank accounts, cashing in stocks or bonds, notifying credit card companies or pursuing property settlements. Cost is \$13.00
